# Precautions

- 1. Please use the DC 5V charger to charge, and do not play music while charging.
- 2. When the microphone is turned on, do not point the microphone to the karaoke unit to avoid howling feedback sound from the speaker.



# Control Buttons & Back views



#### Control and Functions

- 1. **4/Ni** Short press **4/Ni** Play or Pause; Long press **4/Ni** Power On/Off
- 2. Short press of for switching mode (Bluetooth, USB, TF, LINE IN)
- Short press W/- for the previous song; Long press W/- reduce volume
- Short press >> 1/+ for the next song; Long press >> 1/+ increase volume
- 5.VOCAL CUT
- Short press to turn on or off VOCAL OUT
- 6.LED
- Short press LED to switch light mode
- 7.ECHO-
- Long press **ECHO-** to reduce reverberation 8.ECHO+

### Instructions

- When you turn on the power, the default mode of the karaoke speaker is Bluetooth mode; you can search for the device name 'EKS700' in the Bluetooth connection of the mobile phone, and the LED will indicate blue
- When the USB is plugged in, the karaoke speaker turns into USB mode, and the LED turns Orange.

  • When the TF card is inserted, the karaoke speaker turns into TF mode, and
- When the 1.5 turns orange and green.
   When the 3.5 mm audio cable is inserted, the karaoke speaker will switch to LINE IN mode, and the LED will display green.
   When the USB and TF card are inserted, press the button
- When charging, you can use the DC 5V charger to charge the karaoke speaker, the charging light is red, and the red light turns off when the battery is fully charged.

# Instruction of microphone





- 1. Long press the switch of the microphone to turn on the microphone, the microphone will automatically connect to the speaker, and the LED light will display blue; when the speaker is not connected, the LED light will flash blue.

  2. When singing, short press the "VOL+/VOL-" button to control the volume of.

- 3. When singing, short press the "\omega" button to turn on and select the appropriate sound effect.
- 4. When charging, you can use the DC 5V charger to charge the microphone, the charging light is red, and the red light turns off when the battery is fully charged
