Making your own jewellery is so much fun. This kit shows you how to make fabulous necklaces and bracelets with pretty beads and Magical Unicorn charms.

There are enough materials in this kit to make up to 10 Unicorn Charm Jewellery designs, which you'll be proud to wear or give as gifts to friends and family.

- 10 x Silver Colour Metal Charms
- 60 x Bicone Beads Purple & Pink
- 200 x Round Beads Pink, White, Blue, Purple & Silver


- 30 x Pearlescent Beads Green, Pink & White
- 40 x Faceted Beads Green & Yellow
- 10 x Heart Shaped Beads Pink
- 10 x Star Shaped Beads Purple
- 10 x Split Rings (to attach charms)
- 5 x Clasps
- 10 x Clasp Beads
- 5m Stretch Cord
- Colour Instruction Manual

Make your Own!

Unicorn Charm Necklace

- **1.** Choose a unicorn charm and attach a charm split ring onto it.
- 2. Cut 50cm of stretch cord.
- **3.** Thread a charm to the centre of the cord.
- **4.** Now thread 10-15 beads onto one side of the cord. Tie 2-3 knots afterwards.

5. Repeat this on the other end of the cord with the same pattern of beads.




7. On one end of the cord, thread on one half of the clasp, then a small clear bead. Tie a double knot after the bead. Trim off any excess cord, then pull the bead down inside the clasp.



8. Repeat this on the other side.

Hint:

You may need some help to attach the clasp as it can be quite fiddly!

Unicorn Charm Bracelets

You can make pretty bracelets with your dangly charms too!

- 1. Pick out a charm and attach it to a charm split ring. Just as you did when making a necklace.
- **2.** Cut a 25cm length of stretch cord and thread on your charm.
- **3.** Now thread on enough beads to fit around your wrist. Depending on the beads you choose you will need 20-25 beads for one bracelet.



4. Once you have thread on a selection of beads, test the bracelet around your wrist. When you are happy with the length, knot both cord ends together 3 to 4 times pulling the cord very tight each time. Then trim off the ends.

Top Tip!

To make your bracelet extra secure, dab a tiny dot of glue onto the knot to seal it.

Have fun using different charms and bead patterns. Wear them with your favourite outfits or share them with your friends!

Unicorn Charm Bracelets

Hint:

If you want to change the charm on one of your bracelets, you can slide the charm off the charm split ring without undoing your bracelet, then slide on another charm!

You can do this on your necklaces too.
