Keyneton Estate 1994 Shiraz Cabernet Malbec.

*Grape Varieties*

75% shiraz, 15% cabernet, 10% malbec grapes grown in the Eden Valley and Barossa Valley.

*Background*

This estate blend exhibits a complexity of rich fruit flavours and superb balance from the combination of these low yielding, ungrafted dry grown varieties. Matured in new and seasoned American and French oak hogsheads for 12 months, it will continue to develop well in the bottle.

A mild dry summer with a late slow start to vintage, exceptional fruit quality with below average yields.
