*Wine and Vintage*

Keyneton Estate 1993 Shiraz Cabernet Malbec

*Grape Varieties*

80% Shiraz 15% cabernet sauvignon and 5% malbec grapes grown in the Eden Valley and Barossa Valley.

*Vintage Description*

This blend exhibits a complexity of rich fruit flavours and superb balance from the combination of these low yielding, ungrafted dry grown varieties. Matured in new and seasoned American and French oak hogsheads for 12 months, it will continue to develop well in the bottle.

*Wine Description*

Bright deep crimson in colour, lifted sweet plums, chocolate and blackberry fruits complexed with vanilla and scented balsam oak nuances and hints of raspberries and sappiness. The palate shows sweet rich berry fruits, is full, soft and complex, and rounded off with ripe soft tannins and excellent length.
