Wine and Description
Keyneton Estate 1992

Grape Varieties
70% shiraz, 25% cabernet sauvignon and 5% malbec grapes grown in the Eden Valley and Barossa Valley.

Background
This estate blend exhibits a complexity of rich fruit flavours and superb balance from the combination of these low yielding, ungrafted dry grown varieties. Matured in new and seasoned American and French oak hogsheads for 12 months, it will continue to develop well in the bottle.

Wine Description
Bright purple-red in colour, there are delicate red berry fruits in the mulberry and ripe raspberry spectrum and a hint of violets on the bouquet; the palate shows no less luxuriantly sweet berry fruit rounded off with middle palate tannins and excellent length. Good ageing potential.
