WINE and VINTAGE: Mount Edelstone 1990

GRAPE VARIETY: 100% Shiraz planted in 1920 by Ronald Angas, descendant of George Fife Angas. The vineyard, located near Keyneton high in the Barossa Ranges of South Australia, was called Mount Edelstone, meaning gem stone.

DESCRIPTION: The aged vines, soil, climate and traditional winemaking techniques have continued to create one of Australia's most highly regarded Shiraz wines. The 70 year old dry grown vines are low yielding producing intensity of colour, fruit flavours, complexity and palate length. Maturation was carried out in new and seasoned American and French oak hogsheads for one year. The Mount Edelstone wines have received awards at National Wine Shows each year since 1956.

WINE DESCRIPTION: Intense crimson colour, bouquet of rich spicy plum and berry fruits, with vanillin and minty oak, full rich and complex, long soft tannin finish. Potential to develop well in the bottle.
