SONOMA COAST SAUVIGNON BLANC



"Six Ridges" celebrates the unique character of Sonoma County's best wine regions. These wines are named in honor of the mountain ridges that border our vineyards and create the distinctive terroirs.

TASTING NOTES

Our Sauvignon Blanc displays fresh aromas of lime and guava joined by notes of white peach and lemongrass. Beautifully balanced, this wine has a crisp acidity with rich citrus and a refreshing finish.

SONOMA COAST

The sprawling Sonoma Coast appellation embraces Sonoma County's coastline, while spreading north to Mendocino and south to San Pablo Bay. Although this vast region encompasses both the Russian River and Carneros appellations, it is uniformly cool due to the influence of breezes from the nearby Pacific Ocean.

This terroir experiences a long growing season and produces outstanding Sauvignon Blanc with intense flavor and strong varietal character.

FROM THE WINEMAKER

The 2016 vintage had an early dry spring, followed by a long mild summer which gave the vineyards time to slowly mature the fruit to the peak of flavor. Our Six Ridges Sauvignon Blanc was harvested from the best vineyards located in the Russian River and Carneros regions, both of which lie within the Sonoma Coast appellation. Each vineyard lot was harvested at its peak of flavor and fermented separately in stainless steel tanks to preserve the beautiful natural acidity of this wine.
