


CLEANVIEW[®] Canister Vacuum

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING YOUR APPLIANCE.

Unplug from outlet when not in use and before conducting maintenance. When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should be observed, including the following:

△WARNING

TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR INJURY:

- » This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- » Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- » Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts of the appliance and its accessories.
- »Unplug from electrical socket when not in use, before cleaning, maintaining or servicing the appliance, and if your appliance has an accessory tool with a moving brush, before connecting or disconnecting the tool.
- » If the supply cable is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- »Do not run appliance over cable.
- » Do not leave appliance when plugged in.
- » Do not use with damaged cable or plug.
- » Do not pull or carry by cable, use cable as a handle, close door on cable, or pull cable around sharp edges or corners.
- » Keep cable away from heated surfaces.
- » To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cable.
- » Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.
- » Turn off all controls before unplugging.

- » Hold plug when rewinding onto cord reel. Do not allow plug to whip when rewinding.
- » Plastic film can be dangerous. To avoid danger of suffocation, keep away from children.
- » Use only as described in this user guide.
- » Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- » Do not immerse in water or liquid.
- » If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water; do not attempt to operate it and have it repaired at an authorized service center.
- » Do not put any object into openings.
- » Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- » Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- » Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as petroleum, or use in areas where they may be present.
- » Do not pick up toxic material (chlorine bleach, ammonia, drain cleaner, etc.)
- » Do not use appliance in an enclosed space filled with vapours given off by oil base paint, paint thinner, some mothproofing substances, flammable dust, or other explosive or toxic vapours.
- » Do not pick up hard or sharp objects such as glass, nails, screws, coins, etc.
- » Keep appliance on a level surface.
- » Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- » If your appliance has a motorized brushroll, do not leave machine running in the same spot without the handle fully upright.
- » Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- » This appliance is provided with double insulation. Use only identical replacement parts.
- » Do not use to suck up water.
- » Do not immerse in water for cleaning.
- » The hose should be checked regularly and must not be used if damaged.
- » The hose contains electrical wires. Do not use when damaged, cut, or punctured. Avoid picking up sharp objects.
- » Always turn off this appliance before connecting or disconnecting either hose or motorized nozzle.




Push hose connector into body until you hear a "click."




Push handle end into top of extension wand until secure.




Push bottom of extension wand into floor tool until secure.

Accessory clip can be attached to the handle for storage.





The floor tool can be parked on the rear of the unit for storage.


Assembly of Turbine Carpet and Air Driven Floor Tools (select models only)








Operating The Product

△WARNING


Before using your vacuum, make sure that the dirt container is in locked position and that all filters, both pre and post-filters are in place. DO NOT operate your vacuum without these filters.








Floor tool can be used on carpeted and hard floor surfaces. Use on hard floor with the pedal in 'up' position to lower brush bar.




NOTE: Some frieze carpets have long delicate fibers or threads that may be damaged by rotating brush. Turn off the PowerBrush when cleaning this and other similar types of carpet.


Above Floor Cleaning




Remove crevice tool from clip and push onto handle end until secure. Use crevice tool to clean in narrow spaces.



Remove dusting brush from clip and push onto handle end until secure. Use dusting brush to clean multiple off-floor surfaces.









Maintenance: Empty the Dirt Container

To reduce the risk of electrical shock, turn power switch off and disconnect polarized plug from electrical outlet before performing maintenance or troubleshooting checks.






Hold the dirt container over a trash can and press the release button on back.



Cleaning the Filters

∴WARNING


Do not operate vacuum with damp or wet filters, as well as without filters or the Dirt Container in place. Allow components to dry before reassembling the Dirt Container.



With dirt tank removed, twist its top counter-clockwise and pull up.



Grab the pre-motor filter assembly and turn it counter clockwise, pulling up to remove.



Separate foam and pleated filters.




Foam filter can be rinsed to clean. Leave to dry for 24 hours before reassembling.




Pleated filter can be rinsed to clean. Leave to dry for 24 hours before reassembling.




Cyclone system can be easily pulled out of the dirt container.



Disassemble the cyclone system by simply twisting counter-clockwise to separate in to three parts; the black primary cyclone on top, mesh filter frame, and the primary separator beneath the mesh filter frame.



The cyclone system can be rinsed to clean. Leave to dry for 24 hours before reassembling.



To access the post motor filter, press the release button on the back of the vacuum and pull the filter door away.



The post motor filter can be removed from filter door before cleaning. Rinse under tap to clean and allow to dry for 24 hours before reassembling.

Troubleshooting

MARNING

To reduce the risk of electric shock, turn power switch off and disconnect plug from electrical outlet before performing maintenance or troubleshooting checks.

Problem	Possible causes	Remedies
Vacuum	Filters are dirty	Remove and rinse pre-motor and post-motor filters. Allow enough time for them to dry properly before reinserting
	The Main Hose is not connected	Locate the Main Hose and reconnect by pushing the hose connection to secure the latch
won't pick up dirt	• I nore is a crack or noie in the	If there is a crack or hole, order a new Main Hose from the BISSELL website
	There is a clog in the vacuum	Remove debris and any other entanglements that may be restricting its rotation
	The Dirt Container is not seated correctly	Press the Empty Button to release the Dirt Container and reseat properly
Dirt is escaping from the	The Dirt Container is full	Empty the Dirt Container
	Filters are missing	Check to see if all of the Pre-Motor and Post-Motor filters are in place
	The Dirt Container is not seated properly	Press the Empty Button and remove the Dirt Container. Insert the bottom first and pivot the Dirt Container towards the vacuum. Listen for a "click" sound, indicating that it snapped into place
