Grow pea shoots in the flower pots and loop them around the tower using the hooks. Water your garden with the dragon egg or use it to take the baby dragon with you wherever you go!

2. Fill the top pot and flower pots nearly to the top with some sieved garden soil or multi-purpose compost available from garden centres. The soil or compost should be damp but not wet. Firm down the soil.

4. Gently push the pea seeds down into the soil in the flower pots.

5. Carefully water the three growing areas, trying not to overwater. You can use the egg to water these areas if you like.





Caring for your Dragons' Tower Garden

Depending on the temperature, your plants will take a few days to start growing. Place the garden in plenty of light and check every day to ensure that the soil does not dry out. If you keep your Dragons' Tower Garden outdoors, bring it indoors during high winds, heavy rain or throughout winter.

Caring for your Baby Dragon Help the Mummy dragon to love and care for the baby dragon. You can keep him with you in his egg, and the top of the egg clips on and off.
