



### 1 Myrcene

A monoterpene with a fragrance that can be described as peppery, spicy, herbal, floral and woody. Although it has a pleasant odor, it is typically used by the perfume industry as precursor for developing other fragrances. Found in hops, houttuynia, bay, thyme, lemon grass, mango, verbena, cardamom, citrus...etc.

### 2 Linalool

A monoterpenoid alcohol with a fragrance that can be described as spicy, waxy, citrus and floral. It is commonly used as an insecticide against cockroaches, flies, fleas and other insects. Found in basil, lavender, cinnamon, hops, mugwort, goldenrods...etc.

### 3 Terpinolene

Also known as δ-terpinene, it is of four isomers of the monoterpene Terpinene. It has a fragrance that can be described as fresh, woody, piney, herbal with a hint of lemon. Found in conifers, cumin, apple, rosemary, sage, tea tree, lilac, nutmeg...etc.
