


ST GEORGE'S DAY

DRINK SUGGESTIONS

A beer promotion with your favourite local beer or perhaps an 'Olde English' punch. Give some cocktails appropriate names for the evening such as 'St George's Nightcap' or a 'Maiden's downfall'. You could try selling a couple of green cocktails such as 'Dragon's Breath' (Green Chartreuse and lemonade) or a 'Green Dragon' (1/2 measure sure of advocaat 1/2 measure of green crème de menthe, 1 measure of vodka and lemonade to top up. Shake all the ingredients well with ice and pour into a tall glass and then top with lemonade.)

FOOD SUGGESTIONS

Traditional English food such as cold roast beef and apple pie or perhaps 'Dragonburgers' beef burgers with cheese and chilli relish.

FUN AND GAMES

1. Change your loo signs to 'Dragons' and 'Maidens'.
