## 2013 Pinot Noir Tasting Notes

*Varietal blend:* Pinot Noir 100%

*Vintage:* 2013

*Vineyard block:* Premium block 1 (MV6)  
Premium block 12 (D2V5)  
Premium block 21 (MV6)

*Clones:* 59% MV6, 41% D2V5

*Harvest dates:* 28 February-12 March 2013

*Winemaking:* Three parcels were picked and fermented separately in 5-tonne open fermenters. Aged as individual components for 9 months prior to selection and blending pre-bottling. Fined with egg whites and minimally filtered. Bottled January 2014.

*Oak treatment:* Super-premium French Oak (30% new)

*Residual sugar:* <0.5g/litre

*Preservatives:* Sulphur dioxide

*Alcohol:* 13.0%

A bright crimson hue, this deeply complex and refined aromatic profile expresses intense characters of strawberry, black cherry and plum. Allspice, leather and earthy notes abound. Our carefully extracted, home-grown grape tannins are beautifully balanced with those derived from ageing in the finest French oak. This silky Pinot Noir will become even more supple with careful cellaring.
