Winemaker's note

More than an organic wine, Autrement is first and foremost a premium wine meeting the stringent quality requirements common to all the wines Gérard Bertrand. Such constant quality is ensured by the blending of the different terroirs. This range fully expresses Gérard Bertrand's commitment to the environment, recognised by the ECOCERT certification, guaranteeing organic production, a benchmark label for French consumers (85% brand recognition in France), with eco-friendly packaging (labels in recycled paper, untreated cardboard and natural Procork corks). This range is part of our policy of sustainable development focused on preserving our wine-growing landscapes and the drive for a style of farming which respects biodiversity. Ardent defenders of ecology, people enjoying "healthy products", wine-lovers and gourmets looking for new sensations will all find that the Autrement wines live up to their expectations.



Winegrower's note

The grapes are pressed in a pneumatic press as soon as they arrive in the cellar, without any prior maceration. They are then left to settle cold, followed by low-temperature alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel vats to extract the fruit aromas as much as possible. This wine is aged in thermo-regulated stainless steel vats before being early bottled in order to preserve all the freshness of the wine.



Tasting notes

A beautiful salmon-pink colour, soft and glowing. Its delicate and pleasant bouquet reveals intense aromas of red fruits like raspberries, cherries, strawberries and grenadine. Opulent, aromatic and full of roundness, the nose is well balanced and expresses all the complexity that Grenache can translate in our Mediterranean terroir. Fresh on the palate, thirst-quenching and distinct, it develops into aromas of red fruit, then white flowers with red currants in the finish.

Serve at 10°C as an aperitif, with Mediterranean salads, grilled meat, Mediterranean tarts, stuffed peppers or Cantal cheese.

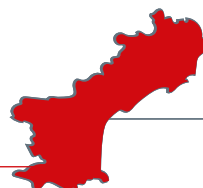
