## Winegrower's note

Narbonne, the 'first daughter' of Rome founded in 118 BC, exported its wines to Europe since ancient times.

Its vineyards benefit from exceptional climate conditions and a limestone-clay terroir that allow the grapes to ripe perfectly.



## Winemaker's note

Once harvested, the grapes pass through a sorting table before being sent to the pneumatic press. After a light settling, the wines ferment in temperature-controlled vats.

After maturing for 6 months on fine lees with a regular stirring of the lees, the wines from the best vats are blended to make up this cuvée.



## Tasting notes

A pale gold colour with hints of green.

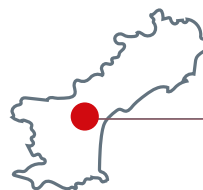
Intense and fresh on the nose with grapefruit and pineapple aromas.

Fresh on the palate with beautiful lemony notes and an invigorating finish.
