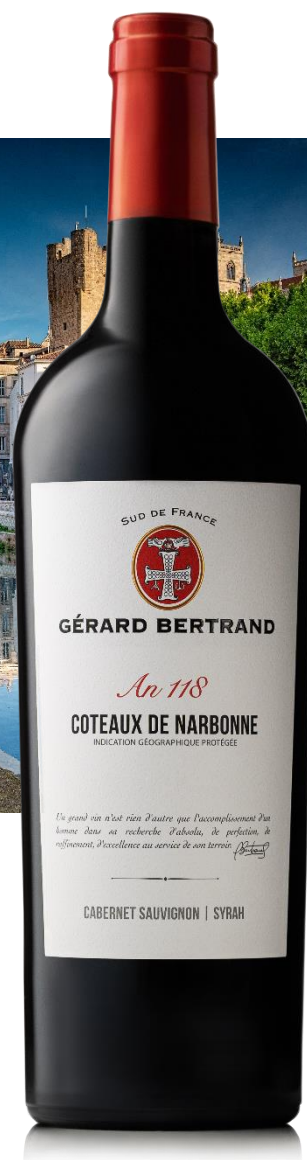
## Winegrower's note

Narbonne, the 'first daughter' of Rome founded in 118 BC, exported its wines to Europe since ancient times. Its vineyards benefit from exceptional climate conditions and a limestone-clay terroir that allow the grapes to ripen perfectly.



## Winemaker's note

The grapes are handpicked. A double manual sorting is made before and after the destemming. Then, the grapes stay for 4 weeks in temperature-controlled vats. When the fermentations are achieved, the wine is aged in vats for 8 months.



## Tasting notes

The wine has a deep red appearance.

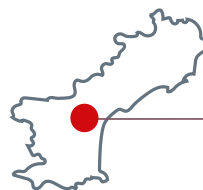
It reveals intense aromas of blueberry and violet on the nose.

Round and gourmet on the palate with beautiful fresh black fruit notes.
