Winemaker's note

With his Réserve Spéciale collection, Gérard Bertrand, a passionate advocate of the Mediterranean Art de Vivre and of the great wines of the South of France, celebrates the elegant, fruity and generous character of the region's finest terroirs. The exceptional terroirs of the Languedoc region, characterised by a sunny climate and low rainfall, help bring out the complexity of the grape varieties which have become emblematic of the South of France, yielding wines of magnificent quality.



Winegrower's note

The grapes are picked at full ripeness. Alcoholic fermentation is carried out under temperature control with traditional maceration. After the malolactic fermentation the wine is matured partly in vats for 8 months in order to conserve the fruit, and partly in oak barrels. After a light fining operation the wine is aged for several months in bottles.



Tasting notes

Endowed with a dark and dense ruby robe. The powerful nose develops aromas of red berries, cherry, wild strawberry, accompanied by intense notes of spices, prune as well as leather and truffle.

The attack on the palate, supple and aromatic, is in harmony with the notes revealed on the nose. Round and elegant, structured and powerful, the finish lingers on the palate.

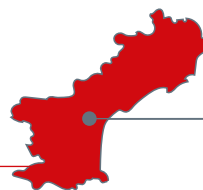
Serve at 18°C with meat, grilled poultry, and mature cheeses.
