


## LION BRAND COTTON <br> THICK \& QUICK ${ }^{\circledR}$ FLOWER BAG

Item \#987A

## SIZE:

$14^{\prime \prime}$ wide, $11 \frac{1}{2}$ " long, $51 / 2$ " deep.

## MATERIALS:

- LION BRAND Cotton Thick \& Quick, Art. No. 720, 4 balls \#098 Natural or solid color of your choice. Note: Solid colors come in 7 oz . balls, multi-colors are 6 oz .
- One pair knitting needles size 11 U.S. (0 U.K.) ( 8.00 mm ) OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE.
- Cable needle (cn).
- Double-pointed needles (dpn) size 11 U.S.


## GAUGE:

10 sts and 13 rows $=4$ " on size 11 needles. TO INSURE PROPER SIZE, BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## PATTERN STITCHES

## Bobble:

(K 1, p 1, k 1, p 1, k 1) in one st, turn and p 5, turn and k 5, turn and p 5, then pass 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th sts on right-hand needle one at a time over the first st completing bobble.

Small Cable A (worked on 2 sts):
Row 1 (RS): SI 1 st to cn and hold in front, k 1, k 1 from cn.
Row 2: P 2. Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Small Cable A.
Small Cable B (worked on 2 sts):
Row 1 (RS): SI 1 st to cn and hold in back, $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ from cn .
Row 2: P 2. Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Small Cable B.
Cable C (worked on 6 sts):
Row 1 (RS): SI 2 sts to cn and hold in front, k 2,
then k 2 from cn, k 2.
Rows 2 and 4: P 6.
Row 3: K 2, sl 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k 2 , then k 2 from cn . Rep Rows 1-4 for Cable C.

Center Panel (worked on 19 sts):
Row 1 (RS): P 8, k 3, p 8.
Rows 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 18, 22 and 26 (WS):
Work as sts appear.
Row 3: P 7, sl 1 st to cn and hold in back, k 1,
then k 1 from $\mathrm{cn}, \mathrm{k} 1$, sl 1 st to cn and hold in front, k 1 , then k 1 from cn, p 7.
Row 5: P 6, sl 1 st to cn and hold in back, k 1, k 1 from cn, $\mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{sl} 1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{to} \mathrm{cn} \mathrm{and} \mathrm{hold} \mathrm{in} \mathrm{front} ,\mathrm{k} \mathrm{1}$,then k 1 from cn, p 6. Row 7: P 5, sl 1 st to cn and hold in back, then p 1 from cn , $\mathrm{k} 5, \mathrm{sl} 1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{to} \mathrm{cn} \mathrm{and} \mathrm{hold} \mathrm{in} \mathrm{front} ,\mathrm{p} \mathrm{1}$,then k 1 from cn, p 5.
Row 9: P 4, (sl 1 st to cn and hold in back, k 1, then p 1 from cn ) 2 times, k 3 , (sl 1 st to cn and hold in front, p 1, then k 1 from cn) 2 times, p 4.
Row 11: P 3, (sl 1 st to cn and hold in back, $k$ 1, then $p 1$ from $\mathrm{cn}) 3$ times, $k$ 1, (sl 1 st to cn and hold in front, p 1, then k 1 from cn) 3 times, $p 3$.

Row 13: P 2, (sl 1 st to cn and hold in back, k 1, then $p 1$ from cn) 2 times, ( $\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ ) 3 times, p 1 , ( sl 1 st to cn and hold in front, p 1 , then k 1 from cn ) 2 times, p 2. Row 15: P 2, Bobble, p 1, k 1, p 2, (k 1, p 1) 3 times, p 1, k 1, p 1, Bobble, p 2.
Row 16: K 4, p 1, k 2, (p 1, k 1) 3 times, k 1, p 1, k 4.
Row 17: P 4, k 1, p 2, (k 1, p 1) 3 times, p 1, k 1, p 4.
Row 19: P 4, Bobble, p 1, sl 1 st to cn and hold in back, k 1 , then p 1 from cn, p 1, k 1, p 1, sl 1 st to cn and hold in front, p 1 , then k 1 from cn, p 1 , Bobble, p 4.
Row 20: K 6, p 1, k 2, p 1, k 2, p 1, $k 6$.
Row 21: P 6, k 1, p 2, k 1, p 2, k 1, p 6.
Row 23: P 6, Bobble, p 2, k 1, p 2, Bobble, p 6.
Row 24: K 9, p 1, k 9 .
Row 25: P 9, k 1, p 9.
Row 27: P 9, Bobble, p 9.
Row 28: K all sts.
Rows 29-36: P on RS, k on WS.

## BACK:

Cast on 43 sts. Est pat as foll: Row 1 (RS): P 2, Cable A, p 2, Cable C, Central Panel, Cable C, p 2, Cable B, p 2. Cont in pat as est for 36 rows. Bind off.

FRONT:
Work same as Back.

## Gusset (Side Panel):

Cast on 12 sts. Rows 1-16: Work in reverse St st (p on RS, k on WS). Row 17: Dec 1 st at beg and end of row. Rows 18 102: Cont even in reverse St st. Row 103: Inc 1 st at beg and end of row. Rows 104-119: Work even in reverse St st. Bind off.

## FINISHING:

Sew gusset (with p side as RS) to one side of tote by stitching down one side, around bottom and up other side. Attach gusset to other side of tote in same manner. Beg at middle of gusset, work 3-st attached I-cord around entire piece. Bind off I-cord and join to beg l-cord as invisibly as possible.

## Attached I-cord:

1. With dpn, cast on 3 sts, then pick up and k 1 st along edge of piece - 4 sts. 2. Slide all sts to opp end of dpn and k 2, then k2tog through back loops, pick up and k 1 st from edge. Rep Row 2 for l-cord.

## Handle (make 2):

Cast on 6 sts. Row 1: SI 1, p 1, k 1, p 1, k 1, p 1.
Rep Row 1 until piece measures 30 ". Bind off.
Attach handle to top of tote at each Cable C.
