SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

SIZE: Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X

Finished Chest (buttoned) 43½ (48½, 54½, 59½, 64½)". Length 22½ (23½, 24½, 25½, 25½) inches. **Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 630-135 Wool-Ease Chunky: Spice
 - 5 (6,7,7,8) Skeins
- Lion Brand Size 10.5 [6.5 mm] 29-inch [75 cm] Circular Needles
- Lion Brand Stitch Holders
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers


GAUGE:

13 sts + 19 rows to 4" (10 cm) over St st. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES:

St st = K on RS, p on WS in rows; k every round for rnds.

SWEATER



Dimensions/Measurements

Neck: 8.5 (9, 10,10, 10.5 inches Sleeve width: 8, (9, 10.5, 11, 12) inches Underarm to hem length: 12.5 (12.5, 12, 12.5 11.5) inches Bottom Hem: 2 inches Bottom circumfrence: 43.5 (49.5, 54.4, 59.5, 64.5) inches Sleeve length excluding hem: (14.5, 14.5, 14, 14, 14) inches Sleeve hem: 2 inches Cuff diameter 8 (9, 10, 10, 11, 11.5) inches

Yoke With circular needle, cast on 38 (40, 42, 42, 44) sts.

Row 1 (WS) P 3, place marker (pm), p 5, pm, p 23 (25, 27, 27, 29), pm, p 5, pm, p 2.

Row 2 (RS) [K to marker, yo, slip marker (sm), k 1, yo] 4 times, k to end - 46 (48, 50, 50, 52) sts. **Row 3** Purl.

Row 4 K 1, M1, [k to marker, yo, sm, k 1, yo] 4 times, k to last st, M1, k 1.

Row 5 Purl.

Rows 6-13 Rep last 2 rows 4 times more - 96 (98, 100, 100, 102) sts.

Row 14 Cast on 9 (10, 11, 11, 14) sts for front neck, work as for row 2 - 113 (116, 119, 119, 124) sts.

Row 15 Cast on 9 (10, 11, 11, 14) sts for front neck, [k 1, p 1] twice, k 1, p to last 5 sts, [k 1, p 1] twice, k 1 - 122 (126, 130, 130, 138) sts.

Row 16 (Buttonhole Row) Work as for row 2 to last 5 sts, k 2, yo, k2tog, k 1. Rep Buttonhole Row every 14th row 1 (3, 6, 2, 2) times, then every 12th row 6 (4, 1, 6, 6) times and AT SAME TIME, continue as follows:

Row 17 and all WS rows to lower band [K 1, p 1] twice, k 1, p to last 5 sts, [k 1, p 1] twice, k 1. Row 18 [K to marker, yo, sm, k 1, yo] 4 times, k to end. Rep last 2 rows 10 (12, 15, 17, 19) times more, working buttonholes when necessary - 218 (238, 266, 282, 306) sts. Next row Rep Row 17.

Divide for body:

Next Row (RS) K 35 (38, 42, 44, 49), remove marker (rm), k 1 (left front), *slip next 42 (46, 52, 56, 60) to hold, rm, cast on 6 (8, 10, 14, 14) sts for underarm*, k 61 (67, 75, 79, 85), rm, k 1, work from * to * once, k 36 (39, 43, 45, 50) - 146 (162, 182, 198, 214) sts. Work even, working all WS rows as established, knitting all RS rows and working buttonholes as indicated until piece measures $20\frac{1}{2}$ ($21\frac{1}{2}$, $22\frac{1}{2}$, $23\frac{1}{2}$), $23\frac{1}{2}$)" from beg, end with a RS row.

Lower band:

Next Row (WS) *K 1, p 1; rep from * across, dec 1 st at center of back—145 (161, 181, 197, 213) sts. **Next row** K 6, *p 1, k 1; rep from * to last 5 sts, k 5. Continue in pat as established until band measures 2", continuing buttonholes as necessary. Bind off in pat.

SLEEVES

Rnd 1 With RS facing and dpns, pick up and k 6 (8, 10, 14, 14) sts along cast-on sts at underarm, pm after 3rd (4th, 5th, 7th, 7th) st, k sts from hold and up to marker - 48 (54, 62, 70, 74) sts. Knit 2 rnds.

Next (dec) rnd K 1, k2tog, k to 3 sts before marker, ssk, k 1. Rep dec rnd every 8th (6th, 6th, 4th, 4th) rnd 2 (7, 1, 10, 9) times, then every 6th (4th, 4th, 2nd, 2nd) rnd 7 (4, 12, 7, 9) times - 28 (30, 34, 34, 36) sts. Work even until sleeve measures $14\frac{1}{2}$ ($14\frac{1}{2}$, 14, 14, 14)" from underarm.

Next rnd *K 1, p 1; rep from *. Rep last rnd until band measures 2". Bind off in rib.

FINISHING

Neckband With RS facing and circular needle, pick up and k 18 (19, 20, 20, 23) along right front to raglan, *1 at raglan, 4 across sleeve, 1 at raglan*, 22 (24, 26, 26, 28) across back, rep from * to * once, 18 (19, 20, 20, 23) along left front - 70 (74, 78, 78, 86) sts. Work in rows as follows:

Row 1 (WS) *K 1, p 1; rep from * around, dec 7 by p2tog as you go in following areas: 1 on each front, 1 at each raglan and 1 at center back - 63 (67, 71, 71, 79) sts.

Row 2 K 5, *k 1, p 1; rep from * to last 5 sts, k 5. Work even in pat as established for 3 more rows. Bind off in pat. Sew on buttons.
