#### **MATERIALS**

- 800-102 [Lion Brand Homespun Baby Yarn: Creamsicle DISCONTINUED](#)  
5 Balls
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5 \(6.5 mm\)](#)

*\*Homespun® Baby (Article #800). 98% acrylic, 2% polyester; package size: Same weight in terms of thickness as regular Homespun, but skeins are half the size of regular Homespun skeins.*



#### **GAUGE:**

4 V-sts + 5 rows = 4 inches (10 cm) in V-st pattern. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### **STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**V-Stitch** (Dc, ch 1, dc) in same stitch.

#### **NOTES:**

Blanket is worked from side to side.

#### **BLANKET**

Ch 88.

**Row 1** (Dc, ch 1, dc) in 5th ch from hook, [skip 2 ch, work V-st in next ch] across to last 2 ch, skip 1 ch, dc in last ch – 28 V-sts and dc at each end of row.

**Row 2** Ch 3, turn; work V-st in each ch1-space across, end dc in top of turning chain.

Repeat Row 2 for V-st pattern until there are a total of 34 rows; ch 1 (instead of ch 3), turn. DO NOT FASTEN OFF.

#### **BORDER**

Sc in each dc and ch1-space across, end 3 sc in last dc; rotate to side, sc evenly along side edge, 3 sc in first ch of foundation ch; sc in each ch across, 3 sc in last ch; sc evenly along rem side edge, end 2 sc in top of last row turning chain, join with slip st to top of first sc.

#### **Picot Edging**

(Ch 2, slip st in second ch from hook, skip 1 sc, slip st in next 2 sc) around, adjusting for corners and end of rnd.  
Fasten off. Weave in ends.
