



LION BRAND® CHUNKY★USA Crochet Squares Project



Skill Level: Easy+

BEGINNER

SIZE

Hat One size fits most

Scarf 6" x 40"

Baby sweater 6 months

Finished chest 24"

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND Chunky★USA
- #153 Amish Black (A)
- #152 Skyscraper Grey (B)
- #158 Yukon Gold (C)
- #113 Patriot Red (D)
- #147 Napa Grape (E)
- #109 Flag Blue (F)
- #132 Gulf Green (G)
- #099 Fisherman (H) or colors of your choice

Hat and Scarf 1 skein each C, D, E, F, and G

Baby Sweater 1 skein each C, D, F, and G

- Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm) crochet hook OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Large-eyed, blunt needle

GAUGE

10 stitches + 12 rows = 4" (10 cm) in single crochet; each block = 6" x 8" (15 x 20 cm).
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTE

Each skein makes approximately 4 to 5 squares. Mix and match projects as desired.

BASIC SQUARE

Chain 16.

Row 1 Single crochet in 2nd chain from hook and in each chain across – 15 single crochet.

Row 2 Chain 1, turn; single crochet in each stitch across – 15 single crochet. Repeat Row 2 until there are a total of 24 rows. Fasten off.

Hat and Scarf

Make 2 squares each in A, B, D and E; make 1 block in C.

Hat

Sew B and D and A and E together across long ends. Place pieces with squares side by side and sew together 2 sides and top seam.

Scarf

Sew blocks along short ends in the following sequence: A, B, C, D, E.

Tassel (Make 2)

With C, wrap yarn around a piece of cardboard the length you want the tassel (the more wraps, the fuller the tassel will be). Slide a double strand of yarn under the top of the tassel and tie tightly. Cut other end open to remove cardboard. Cut another strand of yarn, wrap it tightly around the tassel several times a little below the top knot. Knot, and weave in ends. Attach one tassel each at top corners of hat.

Baby Sweater

Sleeves (Make 2)

Follow Basic Square pattern, changing colors every other row as follows: (2 rows B, 2 rows D, 2 rows A, 2 rows E) 3 times.

Body

Make 1 block each in A, B, D and E. Use B and E for sweater fronts. Sew A and D with long sides together for back. Place fronts on back and sew together 8 stitches at each shoulder to join. Mark fronts and back 4" down from shoulder for sleeve placement. Set long edge of sleeve between markers and sew. Sew sleeve and side seams.
