Mobius Tube Scarf

Sometime called a 'moibus' or even 'moibuis' scarf, this clever cowl is twisted in the middle in the same manner that a 'Moebius' strip is. No matter how you spell it, it is beautiful item!

MATERIALS

- 540-273 [Lion Brand Landscapes Yarn: Spring Desert](#)
2 Balls
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 \[9 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

**Landscapes (old) (Article #540). 50% wool, 50% Acrylic;
package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (55yds/50m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

11 stitches + 14 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch (knit 1 row, purl 1 row) using size 13 (9 mm) knitting needles. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

GAUGE

11 stitches + 14 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch (knit 1 row, purl 1 row) using size 13 (9 mm) knitting needles. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. **Scarf**

Make a slip knot – first stitch on needle. Cast on 17 stitches – total of 18 stitches.

Knit 6 rows (= 3 garter stitch ridges).

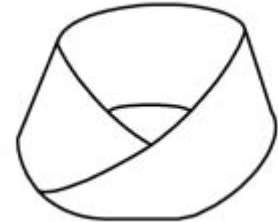
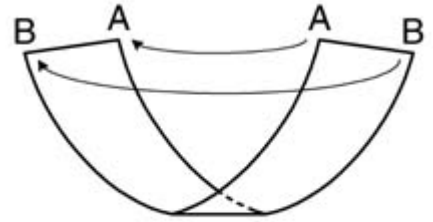
Work in stockinette stitch for 6 rows.

Repeat last 12 rows until piece measures 38 inches or all yarn except 24 inches is used.

Loosely bind off all stitches.

Fold scarf, giving one end a 180 degree turn. Join short ends.

Weave in ends.
