MATERIALS

- 210-132 [Lion Brand Lion Suede Yarn: Olive](#)
4 Balls
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9](#)

*[Lion® Suede](#) (Article #210). 100% Polyester; package size: **Solids:** 3.00 oz./85g; 122 yd/110m balls
Prints: 3:00 oz/85g; 111 yd/100m balls



GAUGE:

5 (half-double crochet, chain 2) spaces + 8 rows = 4 inches [10 cm]. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

SHAWL

Row 1 Chain 4, half-double crochet in first chain to form ring – 1 space made; turn.

Row 2 Chain 4, (*counts as half-double crochet, chain 2*), half-double crochet in ring, chain 2, half-double crochet in ring – 2 spaces made; turn.

Row 3 Chain 4, half-double crochet in first chain-2 space, chain 2, half-double crochet in next chain-2 space, chain 2, half-double crochet in 2nd chain of beginning chain-4 – 3 spaces made; turn.

Row 4 Chain 4, (half-double crochet, chain 2) in each chain-2 space across, half-double crochet in 2nd chain of beginning chain-4 – 4 spaces made; turn.

Repeat Row 4 for 60 times. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
