### MATERIALS

- 320-133 [Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Tangerine](#)  
1 Ball (AA)
- 320-153 [Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Black](#)  
1 Ball (BB)
- 910-186 [Lion Brand Microspun Yarn: Mango](#)  
1 Ball (A)
- 910-153 [Lion Brand Microspun Yarn: Ebony](#)  
1 Ball (B)
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 8 \[5 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

*\*Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size:*

**Solids:** 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls

**Prints:** 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls

**Exotics:** 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (**Note:** Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)



*\*Microspun (Article #910). 100% Micro-Fiber Acrylic;*

*package size: 2.50oz/70.00 gr. (168yds/154m) pull skeins*



### GAUGE:

14 stitches + 24 rows = 4 inches [10 cm] in garter stitch (knit every row) with 1 strand each of Microspun and Fun Fur held together. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### NOTES:

Bag is worked with 1 strand each of Fun Fur and Microspun held together throughout.

### BAG

With 1 strand each of A and AA held together, cast on 38 stitches. Work 4 rows in garter stitch. Change to 1 strand each of B and BB. Work 4 rows in garter stitch. Continue as established, working 4 rows of garter stitch in alternating colors until 26 stripes (104 rows) have been worked. Bind off all stitches.

### STRAP – Make 2

With 1 strand each of A and B held together, cast on 42 stitches. Work 4 rows in garter stitch. Bind off all stitches.

### FINISHING

Fold Bag in half with right sides together. With 1 strand of B, sew bottom and side seams, and sew straps to Bag. Weave in ends.
