MATERIALS

- 320-098 [Lion Brand Fun Fur](#)
Yarn: [Ivory](#)
4 Balls (A)
- 320-124 [Lion Brand Fun Fur](#)
Yarn: [Champagne](#)
4 Balls (B)
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 10 \[6 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

**Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size:*

Solids: 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls

Prints: 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls

Exotics: 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (**Note:** Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)



GAUGE:

9 sts + 17 rows = 4 inches [10 cm] in Garter st (k every row) with 2 strands of yarn held together. When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and k them tog.

M1 (make 1 st) An increase worked by lifting the horizontal thread lying between the needles and placing it onto the left needle. Work this new stitch through the back loop.

SCARF

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, cast on 20 sts. Work in Garter st for 8 inches [20.5 cm].

Eyelet Row (K 1, k2tog, yo) 6 times, k 2.

Work even in Garter st until piece measures 36 inches [91.5 cm] from beginning. Work Eyelet Row once more. Work in Garter st until piece measures 44 inches [112 cm]. Bind off all sts.

HOOD

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, cast on 52 sts. K 22, pm, k 8, pm, k 22. Knit 4 rows.

Increase Row K to marker, M1, sm, k to next marker, sm, M1, k to end of row – 2 sts increased.

Repeat last 5 rows 2 more times – 58 sts. Knit 16 rows.

Decrease Row K to 2 sts before marker, ssk, k to next marker, sm, k2tog, k to end of row.

Knit 3 rows. Repeat last 4 rows 4 more times; repeat Decrease row once more – 46 sts. Bind off.

TIES

(Make 2)

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, cast on 4 sts. Work in Garter st for 23 inches [58.5 cm]. Bind off all sts, leaving a 6 inches [15 cm] tail.

FINISHING

Center cast-on edge of Hood onto one long edge of scarf 12 inches [30.5 cm] from each end. Sew invisibly in place. Fold Hood in half and sew seam at top of Hood. Thread Ties through eyelet rows and attach end securely to lower edge of Scarf. Weave in ends.
