2 Balls

• <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size</u> 11 [8 mm]

<u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u>
 <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>

\*Chenille Thick & Quick® (Article #950). 91% acrylic, 9% rayon; package size: Solids: N/A; 100 yd/90m; Prints: N/A; 75 yd/68m Because of the nature of this yarn, we only give the length, not the weight of the product, as the number of ounces can vary due to the textures of the skein.



#### **GAUGE:**

8 sts and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st (k every row) using size 11 (8mm) needles. When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **WRAP**

Cast on 30 sts. Row 1 Slip 1, knit to end. Repeat Row 1 until 2 yd/2m of yarn left, or to desired width. Bind off all sts loosely. Twisting piece½ turn, sew bound-off edge to cast-on edge.
