Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand® Chenille Thick & Quick® - Fun Fur® Santa Claus Hat Pattern Number: 40314

SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: 3-6 mos, Child 11-12, Adult Medium

Circumference 10¼ (18¼, 20) inches [26 (46.5, 51) cm]

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 950-113 [Lion Brand Chenille Thick & Quick Yarn: Scarlet](#)

1 Ball (MC)
- 320-100 [Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: White](#)
1 Ball (CC)
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 11 \[8 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)
- Additional Materials
½ inches wide elastic band for dog's hat (optional)

**Chenille Thick & Quick® (Article #950). 91% acrylic, 9% rayon; package size: Solids: N/A; 100 yd/90m; Prints: N/A; 75 yd/68m
Because of the nature of this yarn, we only give the length, not the weight of the product, as the number of ounces can vary due to the textures of the skein.*



**Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size: Solids: 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls
Prints: 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls
Exotics: 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (Note: Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)*



GAUGE:

10 sts + 14 rows = 4 inches (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with MC.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

Infant hat pattern was used for the dog

HAT

With MC, cast on 26 (46, 50) sts. Work in St st until piece measures 1 (4, 5) inches from beg. Dec 1 st each end every RS row until 2 sts remain. Break yarn, leaving a long tail to sew seam. Draw through remaining 2 sts, pull tightly, and fasten securely.

CUFF

Divide CC into 3 equal balls. With 3 strands of CC held tog and RS facing, pick up and knit 26 (46, 50) sts along cast on edge of Hat. Knit 6 rows. Bind off all sts loosely. Sew Hat seam.

POMPOM FOR DOG HAT

With 3 strands of CC held tog, cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 Knit in front and back of each st – 8 sts.

Rows 2-4 Knit.

Row 5 K2tog across – 4 sts.

Bind off.

With CC, wind a small ball. Gather top and bottom sts of pompom and fit ball into center to stuff. Sew side seam to form a round pompom. Attach to top of Hat.

POMPOM FOR CHILD AND ADULT HATS

With 3 strands of CC held tog, cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 Knit in front and back of each st – 8 sts.

Row 2 Knit.

Row 3 Repeat Row 1 – 16 sts.

Rows 4-6 Knit.

Row 7 K2tog across – 8 sts.

Row 8 Knit.

Row 9 K2tog across – 4 sts.

Bind off. Finish and stuff as for Dog pompom.
