SIZE: Child 9-10, Adult Medium

6" x 50" (7¼" x 68½") [15 x 127 (18.5 x 174) cm]

1 (2) Ball (MC)
- 320-100 [Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: White](#)
1 Ball (CC)
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 11 \[8 mm\]](#)

**Chenille Thick & Quick® (Article #950). 91% acrylic, 9% rayon; package size: Solids: N/A; 100 yd/90m; Prints: N/A; 75 yd/68m
Because of the nature of this yarn, we only give the length, not the weight of the product, as the number of ounces can vary due to the textures of the skein.*



**Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size: Solids: 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls
Prints: 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls
Exotics: 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (Note: Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)*



GAUGE:

10 sts + 18 rows = 4 inches (10 cm) in garter st (k every row) with MC. When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

SCARF

Divide CC into 3 equal balls. With 3 strands of CC held tog, cast on 15 (18) sts.

Knit 12 (16) rows. Change to MC. Work even in garter st until Scarf measures 47 (65½) inches from beg, or desired length. Change to 3 strands of CC held tog. Knit 11 (15) rows. Bind off all sts loosely. Weave in ends.
