Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand® Chenille Thick & Quick® - Fun Fur® Santa Mittens

Pattern Number: 40316

SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: Child 9-10, Adult Medium

Circumference 6¼ (8¾) inches [16 (22) cm]

Length 6¼ (9½) inches [16 (24) cm]

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 950-113 Lion Brand Chenille Thick & Quick Yarn: Scarlet DISCONTINUED
1 Ball (MC)
- 320-100 Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: White
1 Ball (CC)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 11 [8 mm]
- Lion Brand Stitch Holders
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Chenille Thick & Quick® (Article #950). 91% acrylic, 9% rayon; package size: Solids: N/A; 100 yd/90m;*

Prints: N/A; 75 yd/68m

Because of the nature of this yarn, we only give the length, not the weight of the product, as the number of ounces can vary due to the textures of the skein.



**Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester;*

package size: Solids: 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls

Prints: 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls

Exotics: 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (Note: Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)



GAUGE:

10 sts + 14 rows = 4 inches (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with MC.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

MITTENS

Wind CC into 3 equal balls. With 3 strands of CC held tog, cast on 16 (22) sts. Knit 6 rows. Change to MC. Work 2 (4) rows in St st.

Thumb Gusset

Row 1 K 7 (10), kf&b twice, k 7 (10) – 18 (24) sts.

Row 2 Purl.

Row 3 K 7 (10), kf&b, k 2, kf&b, k 7 (10) – 20 (26) sts.

Row 4 Purl.

Row 5 K 7 (10), kf&b, k 4, kf&b, k 7 (10) – 22 (28) sts.

Row 6 Purl.

Size Adult only K 10, kf&b, k 6, kf&b, k 10 – 30 sts. Purl 1 row.

Sizes Child and Adult K 8 (11), slip next 6 (8) sts onto stitch holder, k 8 (11) – 16 (22) sts. Purl 1 row.

Work even in St st until Mitten measures 2¼ (4½) inches from end of thumb shaping, ending with a WS row.

Mitten Tip

Row 1 K 1, (k2tog, k 1) across – 11 (15) sts.

Row 2 Purl.

Size Adult only (K 1, k2tog) across – 10 sts. Purl 1 row.

Sizes Child and Adult K2tog across, ending k 1(0) – 6 (5) sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing seam. Draw end through remaining sts, gather, and fasten securely.

THUMB

Place 6 (8) sts from holder onto needle. With RS facing, join MC and work 4 (6) rows in St st.

Dec Row K2tog across – 3 (4) sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing seam. Draw end through remaining sts, gather, and fasten securely.

FINISHING

Sew thumb seam. Sew side seam. Weave in ends.
