### Knit Trim for Jeans Jacket

Pattern Number: 50251

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

Collar 3 inches wide x 19 inches long [7.5 x 48 cm] Cuffs 2 inches wide x 8½ inches long [5 x 21.5 cm]

#### MATERIALS

- 320-213 Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Fireworks  
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 6 [4.00 mm]
- Additional Materials  
Sewing needle and matching thread  
Straight pins

Note Measure your garment's collar and cuffs before purchasing yarn. A larger measurement than above will require additional yarn.

100% Polyester;  
package size: **Solids:**  
1.75 oz/50g; 64  
yd/58m balls  
**Prints:** 1.5 oz/40g; 57  
yd/52m balls  
**Exotics:** 1.75 oz/50g;  
55 yd/50m balls (**Note:**  
Exotics shades are lay  
flat to dry)*



#### GAUGE:

22 stitches + 28 rows = 4 inches [10 cm] in Reverse Stockinette Stitch (purl on right side, knit on wrong side). When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### TRIM

##### Collar

Cast on 17 stitches. Work even in Reverse Stockinette Stitch until piece measures same length as jacket collar. Bind off.

##### Cuffs

Cast on 12 stitches.

Work even in Reverse Stockinette Stitch until piece measures same length as jacket cuffs, keeping button and buttonhole uncovered. Bind off.

#### FINISHING

Pin collar and cuffs to jacket. Using sewing needle and thread, sew collar and cuffs along all 4 edges.
