- 790-327 [Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Plantation DISCONTINUED](#)  
2 Balls (A)
- 790-369 [Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Florida Keys Green](#)  
1 Ball (B)
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 10 \[6 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)
- Additional Materials  
Two 1¼ inch [32 mm] black shank buttons for eyes  
Two ¾ inch [19 mm] black shank buttons for nose  
12 oz [340 g] fiberfill stuffing

\*Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester; package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins



**GAUGE:**

9.5 sts + 15 rows = 4 inches [10 cm] in Stockinette st (k on RS, p on WS). When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

**STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**FB** Knit into front and back of st.

**BF** Knit into back and front of st.

**FBF** Knit into front, back, and front of st.

**BFB** Knit into back, front, and back of st.

**ssk (slip, slip, knit)** Slip next 2 sts as if to k, one at a time to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and k them tog.

**NOTES:**

Alligator is knit in pieces – back, belly, and 4 legs. Both the back and belly pieces begin at the tail end, and work toward the head. Because the back is worked in garter stitch, and because it should be slightly rounded when stuffed, it has more rows than the belly piece, and is wider than the belly piece.

## **ALLIGATOR**

### **BACK**

Beginning at tail, with A, cast on 3 sts.

**Row 1 (WS)** Knit.

**Row 2** FB, k 1, BF – 5 sts.

**Row 3** Knit. Join B.

**Row 4** With A, k 2; with B, FBF in next st; with A, k 2 – 7 sts.

**Row 5** With A, k 2; with B, k 1; with A, k 1; with B, k 1; with A, k 2.

**Row 6** With A, FB, k 5, BF – 9 sts.

**Row 7** With A, knit.

**Row 8** With A, k 3; with B, FBF; with A, k 1; with B, BFB; with A, k 3 – 13 sts.

**Row 9** With A, k 3, k2tog, k 3, k2tog, k 3 – 11 sts.

**Rows 10-11** With A, knit.

**Row 12** With A, k 3; with B, FBF; with A, k 3; with B, BFB; with A, k 3 – 15 sts.

**Row 13** With A, k 3, k2tog, k 5, k2tog, k 3 – 13 sts.

**Rows 14-15** With A, knit.

**Row 16** With A, k 3; with B, FBF; with A, k 5; with B, BFB; with A, k 3 – 17 sts.

**Row 17** With A, k 4, k2tog, k 5, k2tog, k 4 – 15 sts.

**Rows 18-19** With A, knit.

**Row 20** With A, k 4; with B, FBF; with A, k 5; with B, BFB; with A, k 4 – 19 sts.

**Row 21** With A, k 5, k2tog, k 5, k2tog, k 5 – 17 sts.

**Rows 22-23** With A, knit.

**Row 24** With A, k 5; with B, FBF; with A, k 5; with B, BFB; with A, k 5 – 21 sts.

**Row 25** With A, k 6, k2tog, k 5, k2tog, k 6 – 19 sts.

**Rows 26-27** With A, knit.

**Row 28** With A, k 6; with B, FBF; with A, k 5; with B, BFB; with A, k 6 – 23 sts.

**Row 29** With A, k 7, k2tog, k 5, k2tog, k 7 – 21 sts.

**Rows 30-31** With A, knit.

**Row 32** With A, k 6; with B, BF next 2 sts; with A, k 5; with B, FB next 2 sts; with A, k 6 – 25 sts.

**Row 33** With A, FB, k 5, k2tog twice, k 5, k2tog twice, k 5, BF – 23 sts.

**Rows 34-35** With A, knit.

**Row 36** With A, k 7; with B, FB next 2 sts; with A, k 5; with B, BF next 2 sts; with A, k 7 – 27 sts.

**Row 37** With A, FB, k 6, k2tog twice, k 5, k2tog twice, k 6, BF – 25 sts.

**Rows 38-39** With A, knit.

**Row 40** With A, k 8; with B, FB next 2 sts; with A, k 5; with B, BF next 2 sts; with A, k 8 – 29 sts.

**Row 41** With A, FB, k 7, with B, k2tog twice, with A, k 5, with B, k2tog twice, with A, k 7, BF – 27 sts.



**Rows 42-43** With A, knit.

**Row 44** With A, k 9; with B, FB next 2 sts; with A, k 5; with B, BF next 2 sts; with A, k 9 – 31 sts.

**Row 45** With A, k 9, with B, k2tog twice, with A, k 5, with B, k2tog twice, with A, k 9 – 27 sts.

**Rows 46-47** With A, knit.

**Rows 48-63** Repeat Rows 44-47 for 4 times.

**Row 64** Repeat Row 44 – 31 sts.

**Row 65** With A, FB, k 8; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 5; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 8, BF – 29 sts.

**Rows 66-67** With A, knit.

**Row 68** With A, k 10; with B, FB next 2 sts; with A, k 5; with B, BF next 2 sts; with A, k 10,– 33 sts.

**Row 69** With A, k 10; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 5; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 10 – 29 sts.

**Rows 70-71** With A, knit.

**Row 72** Repeat Row 68 – 33 sts.

**Row 73** With A, FB, k 9; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 5; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 9, BF – 31 sts.

**Rows 74-75** With A, knit.

**Row 76** With A, k 11; with B, FB next 2 sts; with A, k 5; with B, BF next 2 sts; with A, k 11 – 35 sts.

**Row 77** With A, k 11; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 5; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 11 – 31 sts.

**Rows 78-79** With A, knit.

**Rows 80-127** Repeat Rows 76-79 for 12 times.

**Row 128** With A, k2tog, k 9; with B, FB next 2 sts; with A, k 5; with B, BF next 2 sts; with A, k 9, k2tog – 33 sts.

**Row 129** With A, k 10; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 5; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 10 – 29 sts.

**Rows 130-131** With A, knit.

**Row 132** With A, k 10; with B, FB next 2 sts; with A, k 5; with B, BF next 2 sts; with A, k 10 – 33 sts.

**Row 133** Repeat Row 129.

**Rows 134-135** Knit.

**Rows 136-139** Repeat Rows 132-135.

**Row 140** With A, k2tog, k 8; with B, FB twice; with A, k 5; with B, BF twice; with A, k 8, k2tog – 31 sts.

**Row 141** With A, k 9; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 5; with B, k2tog twice; with A, k 9 – 27 sts.

**Row 142** With A, k 9; with B, k2tog; with A, k 5; with B, k2tog; with A, k 9 – 25 sts.

**Row 143** With A, k 9; with B, FB; with A, k 5; with B, BF; with A, k 9 – 27 sts.

**Row 144** With A, k 9, k2tog, k 5, k2tog, k 9 – 25 sts.

**Row 145** Knit.

**Row 146** With A, k2tog, k 7; with B, FB; with A, k 5; with B, BF; with A, k 7, k2tog – 25 sts.

**Row 147** With A, k 8, k2tog, k 5, k2tog, k 8 – 23 sts.

**Row 148** With A, knit.

**Row 149** With A, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog – 21 sts.

**Row 150** With A, k 7; with B, FB; with A, k 5; with B, BF; with A, k 7 – 23 sts.

**Row 151** With A, k 7, k2tog, k 5, k2tog, k 7 – 21 sts.

**Row 152** With A, knit.

**Row 153** Repeat Row 149 – 19 sts.

**Row 154** With A, k 6; with B, FB; with A, k 5; with B, BF; with A, k 6 – 21 sts.

**Row 155** With A, k 6, k2tog, k 5, k2tog, k 6 – 19 sts.

**Row 156** With A, knit.

**Row 157** With A, repeat Row 149 – 17 sts.

**Row 158** With A, k 5; with B, FB; with A, k 5; with B, BF; with A, k 5 – 19 sts.

**Row 159** With A, k 5, k2tog, k 5, k2tog, k 5 – 17 sts.

**Row 160** With A, repeat Row 149 – 15 sts.

**Row 161** With A, knit.

**Row 162** With A, k 4; with B, FB; with A, k2tog, k 1, k2tog; with B, BF; with A, k 4 – 15 sts.

**Row 163** Cut B. With A, k 4, k2tog, k 3, k2tog, k 4 – 13 sts.

**Row 164** With A, k 1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k 1 – 11 sts.

**Row 165** With A, knit.

**Row 166** With A, k 1, k2tog, k 5, k2tog, k 1 – 9 sts.

**Rows 167-170** With A, knit.

Bind off.

## BELLY

With B, cast on 4 sts.

**Row 1** Purl.

**Row 2** FB, k 2, BF – 6 sts.

**Row 3** Purl.

**Row 4** Change to A, knit.

**Row 5** Change to B, purl.

**Rows 6 and 8** FB, k to last st, BF – 10 sts at end of Row 8.

**Rows 7 and 13** With B, purl.

**Row 9** Change to A, purl.

**Row 10** Change to B, FB, k to last st, BF – 12 sts.

**Row 11** With B, purl.

**Row 12** FB, k to last st, BF – 14 sts.

**Row 14** Change to A, knit.

**Row 15** Change to B, purl.

**Row 16** Knit.

**Row 17** Purl.

**Row 18** FB, k to last st, BF – 16 sts.



**Row 19** Change to A, purl.

**Row 20** Change to B, knit.

**Rows 21 and 23** Purl.

**Row 22** FB, k to last st, BF – 18 sts.

**Row 24** Change to A, knit.

**Row 25** Change to B, purl.

**Rows 26 and 28** Knit.

**Row 27** Purl.

**Row 29** Change to A, purl.

**Row 30** Change to B, knit.

**Rows 31 and 33** Purl.

**Row 32** Knit.

**Rows 34-48** Repeat Rows 24-33 once, then Rows 24-28 once more.

**Row 49** Change to A, purl.

**Row 50** Change to B, FB, k to last st, BF – 20 sts.

**Rows 51 and 53** Purl.

**Row 52** Knit.

**Row 54** Change to A, knit.

**Row 55** Change to B, purl.

**Row 56** FB, k to last st, BF – 22 sts.

**Row 57** Purl.

**Row 58** Knit.

**Row 59** Change to A, purl.

**Row 60** Change to B, knit.

**Row 61** Purl.

**Row 62** FB, k to last st, BF – 24 sts.

**Row 63** Purl.

**Row 64** Change to A, knit.

**Row 65** Change to B, purl.

**Rows 66 and 68** Knit.

**Row 67** Purl.

**Row 69** Change to A, purl.

**Row 70** Change to B, knit.

**Row 71 and 73** Purl.

**Row 72** Knit.

**Rows 74-93** Repeat Rows 64-73 twice.

**Row 94** Change to A, knit.

**Row 95** Change to B, purl.

**Row 96** Knit.

**Row 97** Purl.

**Rows 98** K2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog – 22 sts.

**Row 99** Change to A, purl.

**Row 100** Change to B, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog – 20 sts.

**Row 101** With B, p 2; with A, p 1; with B, p to last 3 sts; with A, p 1; with B, p 2.

**Row 102** With B, k2tog; with A, k 1; with B, k to last 3 sts; with A, k 1; with B, k2tog – 18 sts.

**Row 103** With B, p 1; with A, p 1; with B, p to last 2 sts; with A, p 1; with B, p 1.

**Row 104** With B, k 1; with A, ssk; with B, k to last 3 sts; with A, k2tog; with B, k 1 – 16 sts.

**Row 105** Repeat Row 103.

**Row 106** With B, k 1; with A, k 1; with B, k to last 2 sts; with A, k 1; with B, k 1.

**Row 107** Repeat Row 103.

**Row 108** Repeat Row 104 – 14 sts.

**Row 109** Repeat Row 103.

**Row 110** Repeat Row 106.

**Row 111** Repeat Row 103.

**Row 112** Repeat Row 106.

**Row 113** Repeat Row 103.

**Row 114** Repeat Row 104 – 12 sts.

**Row 115** Repeat Row 103.

**Row 116** Repeat Row 106.

**Rows 117-122** Repeat Rows 105-106 for 3 times.

**Row 123** With B, p 1; with A, p to last st; with B, p 1. Cut A.

**Row 124** With B, k2tog, k to last st, k2tog – 10 sts.

**Row 125** Purl.

Bind off.

#### **LEGS – Make 4**

##### **Toe**

With A, and leaving a long tail, cast on 3 sts.

**Row 1** Knit.

**Row 2** FB, k 1, BF – 5 sts.

**Row 3** Knit.

**Rows 4 and 8** FB, knit to last st, BF – 9 sts at end of Row 8.

**Rows 5-7** Knit.

**Rows 9-11** Knit.

Cut yarn, leaving these 9 sts on needle. Make 3 more Toes in same manner, leaving 36 total sts on needle.

**Row 12 (Join toes)** \*K2tog, k 1; repeat from \* across – 24 sts.**Row 13** Knit, k2tog between each Toe.

Knit 44 rows. Bind off.

**FINISHING**

Fold each ~~toe~~ Toe and use long tail to sew from cast-on edge to Row 11. Stuff each toe.

**Underside Strip for Legs – Make 4**

With B, cast on 8 sts. Beginning with a k row, work in St st for 10 rows.

**Next Row:** K2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog. Continue in St st on 6 sts until piece measures same length as Leg from Toe joining to top of Leg. Bind off.

Pin Underside Strip for Legs between side edges of each Leg and sew into place. Lightly stuff Legs.

Place markers on each side of Belly, at 9½", 13", 18", and 21½ inches [24, 33, 45.5, and 54.5 cm]. Sew Belly to Back of Alligator, leaving seam open between first and 2nd markers and between 3rd and 4th markers on each side, and leaving an opening for stuffing. Sew Legs into marked openings. Stuff Alligator and finish sewing closed.

Sew on buttons for eyes and nose.
