MATERIALS

- 210-205 [Lion Brand Lion Suede Yarn: Waterlilies Print](#)
2 Balls
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 \[5.5 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9](#)

Lion® Suede (Article #210). 100% Polyester; package size: **Solids: 3.00 oz./85g; 122 yd/110m balls
Prints: 3:00 oz/85g; 111 yd/100m balls*



GAUGE:

15 sts + 22 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Seed st. When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

Seed Stitch (odd number of sts)

Row 1 K 1, (p 1, k 1) across.

Repeat Row 1 for Seed st.

SCARF

Cast on 15 sts. Work in Seed st for 72 inches [183 cm]. Bind off all sts.

FRINGE

Cut 48 strands of yarn approximately 16 inches [40.5 cm] long. For each fringe, hold 3 strands of yarn together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of garment, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make 8 fringes along each short side. Trim fringe if necessary.
