**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** Small, Medium

**S (M)**

**Length** About 20 (26 1/2)" [51 (67.5) cm] after felting

**Width** About 13 (17)" [33 (43) cm] after felting

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Mar 21, 2006)

**BASE**

With A, work as for Top until there are ~~16 (22) sc between 2sc groups~~ 156 (~~196~~ 208) sc.

~~**Size M Only** Work 2 additional rnds as follows:~~

~~**Rnd 1** Sc in first 23 sc, [(2 sc in next sc, sc in next 23 sc) 3 times, sc to marker] twice – 202 sc.~~

~~**Rnd 2** Sc in first 12 sc, [(2 sc in next sc, sc in next 24 sc) 3 times, sc to marker] twice – 208 sc.~~

~~**Both Sizes**~~

~~Slip st in each sc around. Fasten off.~~

**MATERIALS**

- 150-098 Lion Brand Fisherman's Wool: Natural  
2 (3) Skeins (A)
- 320-101 Lion Brand Fun Fur: Soft Pink  
4 (5) Skeins (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
1 lb [450 g] polyester fiberfill

**GAUGE:**

13 sc = 4 inches [10 cm] with A before felting. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

**STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**Sc2tog (sc decrease)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**TOP**

With A, ch 27 (35).

**Rnd 1** 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in 24 (32) ch, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of foundation ch, work 24 (32) sc, place marker in first st (always move marker to first st of each rnd) – 54 (70) sc.

**Rnd 2** [2 sc in next sc] 3 times, sc in 24 (32) sc, place 2nd marker in next st, [2 sc in next sc] 3 times, sc in 24 (32) sc – 60 (76) sc.

**Rnd 3** [(2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) 3 times, sc to marker] twice – 66 (82) sc.

**Rnd 4** [(2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) 3 times, sc to marker] twice – 72 (88) sc.

Continue in this manner, working 1 more sc after each 2sc-group on each rnd, until there are 22 (30) sc after each 2sc-group – 192 (256) sc. Add 1 strand of B to A and work with 2 strands held together. Work 4 rnds even in sc. Remove markers, work 6 (8) sc, place first marker in next st.

**Rnd 1** \*Sc in 11 (16) sc, [sc2tog, sc in 22 (30) sc] twice, sc2tog, sc in 11 (16) sc, sc in 24 (30) sc\*\*, place 2nd marker in next st; rep from \* to \*\* – 186 (250) sts.

**Rnd 2** \*[Sc2tog, sc in 21 (29) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 180 (244) sts.  
**Rnd 3** Sc in 10 (14) sc, \*[sc2tog, sc in 20 (28) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 174 (238) sts.  
**Rnd 4** Sc in 19 (27) sc, \*[sc2tog, sc in 19 (27) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 168 (232) sts.  
**Rnd 5** Sc in 9 (13) sc, \*[sc2tog, sc in 18 (26) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 162 (226) sts.  
**Rnd 6** \*[Sc2tog, sc in 17 (25) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 156 (220) sts.  
**Rnd 7** Sc in 8 (12) sc, \*[sc2tog, sc in 16 (24) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 150 (214) sts.  
**Rnd 8** Sc in 15 (23) sc, \*[sc2tog, sc in 15 (23) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 144 (208) sts.  
**Rnd 9** Sc in 7 (11) sc, \*[sc2tog, sc in 14 (22) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 138 (202) sts.  
**Rnd 10** \*[Sc2tog, sc in 13 (21) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 132 (196) sts.  
**Rnd 11** Sc in 6 (10) sc, \*[sc2tog, sc in 12 (20) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 126 (190) sts.  
**Rnd 12** Sc in 11 (19) sc, \*[sc2tog, sc in 11 (19) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 120 (184) sts.  
**Rnd 13** Sc in 5 (9) sc, \*[sc2tog, 10 (18) sc] 3 times, sc to marker; rep from \* once – 114 (178) sts.  
**Rnd 14** Sc in each sc around. Fasten off.

## BASE

With A, work as for Top until there are 16 (22) sc between 2sc-groups – 156 (208) sc. Slip st in each sc around. Fasten off.

## FELTING

Wash by machine on a hot wash/cold rinse cycle with detergent and several pieces of clothing to agitate. To felt additionally, dry by machine on a regular setting until almost dry. Remove from dryer and pull into shape.

## FINISHING

Lay Top on a flat surface and stuff fiberfill around ring. Pin top edge down to form a roll about 4" [10 cm] across. Sew in place, adding fiberfill as needed. Turn Top over and center Base onto it. Sew Base to Top, leaving a 4" [10 cm] opening. Stuff with fiberfill, then finish sewing seam.
