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SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

MATERIALS

• 320-153 Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Black 2 Balls (A)

• 320-133 Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Tangerine 2 Balls (B)

• Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 11 [8 mm]

• Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size:

Solids: 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls

Prints: 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls **Exotics:** 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (**Note:** Exotics

shades are lay flat to dry)



GAUGE:

16 sts = 4 inches [10 cm] in K2, P2 Ribbing with 2 strands Fun Fur held together. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

K2, P2 RIBBING Row 1

*K2, p2; rep from *. Row 2 Repeat row 1.

NOTES:

When changing colors, leave a 6" [15 cm] tail.

COLOR PATTERN

Rows 1-5 1 strand each A and B held together.

Rows 6-10 2 strands B held tog.

Rows 11-15 1 strand each A and B held tog.

Rows 16-20 2 strands A held tog.

Repeat rows 1-20 for color pattern.

SCARF

(**Note:** Scarf is knit with two strands Fun Fur held together.)

With 2 strands of A held tog, cast on 16 sts. Work 5 rows in K2, P2 Ribbing. Change to 1 strand of A and 1 strand of B and work in K2, P2 Ribbing in color pattern. Repeat rows 1-20 color pattern until scarf measures 72" [183 cm] from beginning. Bind off in rib.	
finishing	
Do not weave in ends. Leave yarn tails to give scarf a ragged look
