SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

SIZE: Child 4, Child 5-6, Child 7-8

Finished Chest 30 (34, 38)" [76 (86.5, 96.5) cm]

Length 14 (15, 16) inches [35.5 (38, 40.5) cm]

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 320-100 Fun Fur: White
8 (10,12) Skeins (A)
- 320-124 Fun Fur: Champagne
4 (5,6) Skeins (B)
- 570-150 Festive Fur-Silver
1 Skeins (C)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 11 [8 mm]
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
Yarn Bobbins

GAUGE:

8 sts + 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Seed st with 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held tog. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Seed Stitch (multiple of 2 sts)

Row 1 *K 1, p 1; rep from *.

Row 2 Knit the purl sts and purl the knit sts.
Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

NOTES:

Coat is worked with 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held together for 3 strands total. For "pelt line" detail, 1 strand of C is added for 4 strands total.

BACK

Wind 60" [152.5 cm] of C on each of 4 bobbins and set aside. With 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held tog, cast on 30 (34, 38) sts.

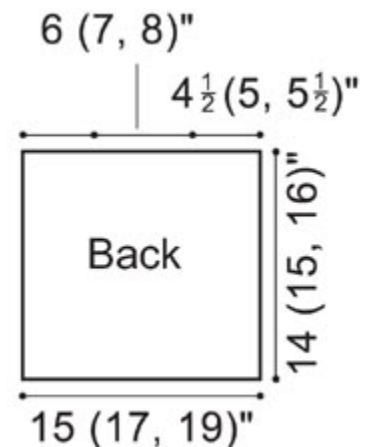
Row 1 (RS) Working in Seed st, work 4 (6, 8) sts, *join 1 strand of C on bobbin and p 1 with 4 strands held tog, drop C and work 6 sts; rep from * to last 5 (7, 9) sts, join 1 strand of C on bobbin and p 1 with 4 strands held tog, drop C and work 4 (6, 8) sts.

Row 2 Working in Seed st, work 4 (6, 8) sts, *k 1 with 4 strands held tog, drop C and work 6 sts; rep from * to last 5 (7, 9) sts, k 1 with 4 strands held tog, drop C and work 4 (6, 8) sts. There are 4 "pelt lines" made by adding 1 strand of C. Continue as established until piece measures 13 (14, 15)" [33 (35.5, 38) cm] from beg; end with a WS row.

Shape Shoulders

Bind off 9 (10, 11) sts at beg of next 2 rows – 12 (14, 16) sts.

Next Row K2tog, bind off to last 2 sts, k2tog, and bind off.



LEFT FRONT

Wind 60" [152.5 cm] of C on 1 (2, 2) bobbin(s) and set aside. With 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B, cast on 6 (8, 10) sts.

Row 1 (RS) Working in Seed st, work 5 sts, join 1 strand C on bobbin and p 1 with 4 strands held tog, drop C and work to end, cast on 2 sts – 8 (10, 12) sts.

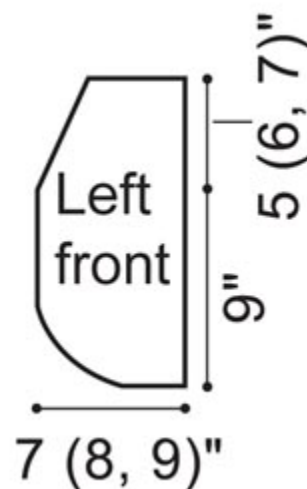
Row 2 (WS) Work 2 (4, 6) sts, k 1 with 4 strands held tog, drop C and work 5 sts. Continue as established, casting on 2 sts at end of next 2 RS rows and adding "pelt lines" of C every 7th st from previous "pelt line" – 12 (14, 16) sts.

Continue as established, casting on 1 st at end of next 2 RS rows – 14 (16, 18) sts. Work even until piece measures 9" [23 cm] from beg; end with a RS row.

Shape Neck

Next Row (WS) Bind off 2 sts at neck edge, work to end of row.

Next Row (RS) Work even in pattern as established. Rep last 2 rows until 10 (10, 12) sts remain, then bind off 1 (0, 1) st(s) at beg of next WS row – 9 (10, 11) sts. Work even until piece measures 14 (15, 16)" [35.5 (38, 40.5) cm] from beg. Bind off all sts.

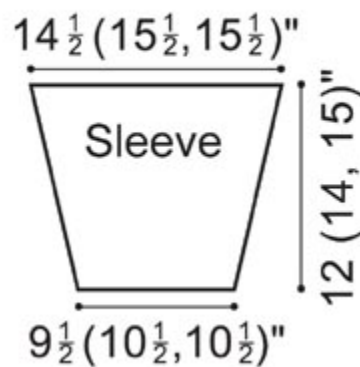


RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Left Front, reversing shaping.

SLEEVES

With 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B, cast on 19 (21, 21) sts. Work in Seed st for 5 rows. Join 1 strand C and work 1 row with 4 strands held tog, increasing 1 st at beg and end of row – 21 (23, 23) sts. Drop C and work 5 rows even. Rep last 6 rows 4 more times – 29 (31, 31) sts. Work even until piece measures 12 (14, 15)" [30.5 (35.5, 38) cm] from beg. Bind off.



FINISHING

With C, sew shoulder seams. Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams. Optional Edging With RS facing, join 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B to bottom of Right Front. With crochet hook, slip st up Right Front, across Back Neck and down Left Front. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
