# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand® Microspun Speed Hook Earflap Hat

Pattern Number: 60422

**SKILL LEVEL**: Easy

SIZE: 9 mos, 24 months (2 yrs), Child 4, Child 9-10, Adult Medium

Hat Circumference 16½ (18½, 20½) in. [42 (47, 52) cm]

**Scarf** 5 x 60 in. [12.5 x 152.5 cm]

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it

applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Nov 15, 2006)

For Child Size ONLY Row s 4-8: Repeat Row 3.

For Adult Size ONLY Row s 4- 10: Repeat Row 3.

## **MATERIALS**

- 910-150 Lion Brand Microspun: Sterling
  - 1 Skeins (A)
- 910-134 Lion Brand Microspun: Leaf
  - 1 Skeins (B)
- 910-102 Lion Brand Microspun: Blush
  - 1 Skeins (C)
- 910-146 Lion Brand Microspun: Fuchsia
  - 1 Skeins (D)
- · Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size S-35 'Speed Hook'
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- · Additional Materials
  - 3 in. [7.5 cm] wide piece of cardboard

#### GAUGE:

8 sts + 8 rows = 4 in. [10 cm] in (sc, ch 1) pattern using 1 strand each of A, B, C, and D held together. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc decrease) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

# **SCARF**

Using 1 strand each of A, B, C, and D held together, ch 10.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and every ch across – 9 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk 1 sc, sc in next sc) across – 4 ch-1 sp.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) across. Repeat Row 3 until piece measures 60 in. [152.5 cm] from beg.

**Edging:** Turn, 3 sc in first sc, sc in next ch-1 sp, \*sc in next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from \* across to last sc, 3 sc in last sc; turn to work along side edge, sc evenly along side of scarf, 3 sc in corner; turn to work along opposite side of beg ch, sc in each ch across, 3 sc in corner; turn to work along remaining side, sc evenly along side of scarf; join with sl st in top of first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

#### HAT

Using 1 strand each of A, B, C, and D held together, ch 34 (38, 42).

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and every ch across – 33 (37, 41) sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk 1 sc, sc in next sc) across - 16 (18, 20) ch-1 sp.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) across.

#### For Infant Size ONLY

Rows 4-8: Repeat Row 3.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc, ch 1, sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) across – 8 (9, 10) ch-1 sp.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk ch-1 sp, sc in next 2 sc) across.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next 2 sc) across, end sk last ch-1 sp, sc in last sc - 17 (19, 21) sc.

Row 12: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk 1 sc, sc in next sc) across – 8 (9, 10) ch-1 sp.

Row 13: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc, ch 1, sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) across – 4 ch-1 sp.

Row 14: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next 2 sc) across – 9 sc.

**Row 15:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog across, end sc in last sc – 5 sc.

**Row 16:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk 1 sc, sc in next sc) across – 2 (2, 1) ch-1 sp. Fasten off, leaving a 10 in. [25.5 cm] tail. Weave tail through top loops of remaining sts and gather tightly. Fasten securely.

#### For Child Size ONLY

Rows 4-8: Repeat Row 3.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc, ch 1, sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) across – 8 (9, 10) ch-1 sp.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk ch-1 sp, sc in next 2 sc) across.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next 2 sc) across, end sk last ch-1 sp, sc in last sc - 17 (19, 21) sc.

**Row 12:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk 1 sc, sc in next sc) across – 8 (9, 10) ch-1 sp.

**Row 13:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc, ch 1, sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) across, end sk last ch-1 sp, sc in last sc - 4 ch-1 sp.

Row 14: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next 2 sc) across -10 sc.

Row 15: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog across – 5 sc.

**Row 16:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk 1 sc, sc in next sc) across – 2 (2, 1) ch-1 sp. Fasten off, leaving a 10 in. [25.5 cm] tail. Weave tail through top loops of remaining sts and gather tightly. Fasten securely.

#### For Adult Size ONLY

Rows 4-10: Repeat Row 3.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc, ch 1, sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) across – 8 (9, 10) ch-1 sp.

Row 12: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk ch-1 sp, sc in next 2 sc) across.

Row 13: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next 2 sc) across, end sk last ch-1 sp, sc in last sc – 17 (19, 21) sc.

**Row 14:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk 1 sc, sc in next sc) across – 8 (9, 10) ch-1 sp.

Row 15: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc, ch 1, sk ch-1 sp, sc in next sc) across – 5 ch-1 sp.

Row 16: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (sk ch-1 sp, sc in next 2 sc) across – 11 sc.

**Row 17:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog across, end sc in last sc – 6 sc.

Row 18: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog across – 3 sc.

**Row 19:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, (ch 1, sk 1 sc, sc in next sc) across – 2 (2, 1) ch-1 sp. Fasten off, leaving a 10 in. [25.5 cm] tail. Weave tail through top loops of remaining sts and gather tightly. Fasten securely.

#### **Earflaps**

Beg on opposite side of beg ch and holding 1 strand each of A, B, C and D together; sk first 3 (4, 5) ch, join yarn in next ch.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in same ch as join and next 7 ch – 8 sc.

Work 0 (1, 2) rows in sc over the 8 sc.

**Next Row:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc across to last 2 sc, sc2tog – 6 sc.

Next Row: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Repeat last 2 rows until 2 sc remain.

**Next Row:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog – 1 sc. Fasten off.

Sk next 11 (13, 15) ch of beg ch, join yarn in next ch and repeat from Row 1 for second earflap.

# FINISHING

#### Edging

Using 1 strand each of A, B, C, and D held together, join yarn at edge of opposite side of beg ch, sc in first 3 (4, 5) ch; \*sc evenly along side of earflap, ch 6, sl st into 2nd ch from hook and remaining ch, sc evenly along next side of earflap\*\*, sc in 11 (13, 15) front brim sts; repeat from \* to \*\*, sc in remaining 3 (4, 5) ch. Fasten off. Sew back seam. Weave in ends.

# Tassel (make 2)

Using 1 strand each of A, B, C, and D held together, wrap yarn around cardboard 15 times. Cut a 10 in. [25.5 cm] length of yarn and thread into large-eyed blunt needle. Insert needle under all strands at one end of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at opposite end of cardboard. Cut a 10 in. [25.5 cm] length of yarn and wrap tightly

around loops 1 in. [2.5 cm] below knot to form Tassel neck. Knot securely. Weave tie ends into center of Tassel. Trim Tassel ends evenly. Sew a Tassel to end of each Earflap.
