#### MATERIALS

- 790-403 [Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Earth](#)  
1 Ball
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-8](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)
- Additional Materials  
2 plastic safety eyes, 12 mm diameter  
Fiberfill stuffing  
Small amount of black yarn

#### GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not important to this project

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts tog)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

#### NOTES:

Work in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.

#### HEAD

Ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Place marker for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each st around - 12 sts.

**Rnd 3:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) 6 times - 18 sts.

**Rnd 4:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) 6 times - 24 sts.

**Rnd 5:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts) 6 times - 30 sts.

**Rnd 6:** (2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts) 6 times - 36 sts.

**Rnds 7-15:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 16:** (Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts) 6 times - 30 sts.

**Rnd 17:** (Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts) 6 times - 24 sts.

**Rnd 18:** (Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts) 6 times - 18 sts.

Fasten off.

#### BODY

Ch 2.

**Rnds 1-5:** Rep Rnds 1-5 of Head - 30 sts.

**Rnd 6:** Sc in next 14 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in next 14 sc - 32 sts.

**Rnd 7:** Sc in next 15 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in next 15 sc - 34 sts.

**Rnd 8:** Sc in next 16 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in next 16 sc - 36 sts.

**Rnds 9-14:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 15:** Sc in next 16 sts, (sc2tog) twice, sc in next 16 sts - 34 sts.

**Rnd 16:** Sc in next 15 sts, (sc2tog) twice, sc in next 15 sts - 32 sts.

**Rnd 17:** Sc in next 14 sts, (sc2tog) twice, sc in next 14 sts - 30 sts.

**Rnd 18:** Sc in next 13 sts, (sc2tog) twice, sc in next 13 sts - 28 sts.

**Rnd 19:** Sc in next 12 sts, (sc2tog) twice, sc in next 12 sts - 26 sts.

**Rnd 20:** Sc in next 11 sts, (sc2tog) twice, sc in next 11 sts - 24 sts.

**Rnd 21:** (Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts) 6 times - 18 sts.

Fasten off.

#### EARS (make 2)

Ch 2.

**Rnds 1-3:** Rep Rnds 1-3 of Head - 18 sts.

Fasten off.

#### ARMS (make 2)

Ch 2.

**Rnds 1 and 2:** Rep Rnds 1 and 2 of Head - 12 sts.

**Rnd 3:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 4:** Sc2tog, sc in next 8 sts, sc2tog - 10 sts.

**Rnds 5-14:** Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

#### LEGS (make 2)

Ch 2.

**Rnds 1-3:** Work Rnds 1-3 of Head - 18 sts.

**Rnds 4 and 5:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 6:** Sc2tog, sc in next 14 sts, sc2tog - 16 sts.

**Rnd 7:** Sc2tog, sc in next 12 sts, sc2tog - 14 sts.

**Rnds 8-18:** Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Following package directions, attach safety eyes to Head.

Firmly stuff Head. With black yarn, embroider straight st nose. Fold Ears in half to make semi-circles and sew closed. Sew Ears to Head.

Firmly stuff Body, sew Head to Body. Stuff Arms and Legs lightly and sew to Body. Weave in ends.
