



# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand. Lion Suede

# **Matinee Jacket**

Pattern Number: 60682

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

SIZE: Small, Medium, Large, 2X

Finished Bust 38 (42, 48, 54) in. (96.5 (106.5, 122, 137) cm)

Finished Length 181/2 (181/2, 201/2, 211/2) in. (47 (47, 52, 54.5) cm)

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jul 30, 2008)

#### Sleeves

Rep last 4 rows **#** 3 more times - 46 (50, 54, 62) sts.

# **MATERIALS**

• 210-146 Lion Brand Lion Suede Yarn: Fuchsia

- 8 (9, 10, 11) Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size J-10
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
  - 1. Sewing needle and thread
  - 2. 1 button, 1 in. (2.5 cm) diameter

# GAUGE:

11 sts +  $9\frac{1}{2}$  rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Griddle stitch. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc dec) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**dc2tog (dc dec)** Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

# PATTERN STITCH

# Griddle Stitch (over even # of sts)

**Row 1:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across. Rep Row 1 for Griddle Stitch.

# Griddle Stitch (over odd # of sts)

**Row 1:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, \*dc in next sc, sc in next dc; rep from \* across. **Row 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as st), turn, dc in first sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Griddle Stitch.

#### BACK

#### Ch 55 (59, 67, 77).

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, \*sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from \* across – 54 (58, 66, 76) sts. Work in Griddle st until piece measures 9 (9, 10, 10) in. (23 (23, 25.5, 25.5) cm) from beg.

#### Shape Raglans

**Row 1:** SI st in first 2 (3, 4, 4) sts, work in Griddle st across to last 2 (3, 4, 4) sts; leave last 2 (3, 4, 4) sts unworked – 50 (52, 58, 68) sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, work in Griddle st across to last 2 sts, dc2tog.

Rep last row 18 (19, 20, 24) more times -12 (12, 16, 18) sts. Work even in Griddle st until raglans measure  $9\frac{1}{2}$  (9 $\frac{1}{2}$ , 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ , 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) in. (24 (24, 26.5, 29) cm). Fasten off.



Ch 31 (33, 37, 41).\

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, \*sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from \* across – 30 (32, 36, 40) sts. Work in Griddle st until piece measures 9 (9, 10, 10) in. (23 (23, 25.5, 25.5) cm) from beg.

#### Shape Raglan

**Row 1:** Work in Griddle stitch across to last 2 (3, 4, 4) sts; leave last 2 (3, 4, 4) sts unworked – 28 (29, 32, 36) sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, work in Griddle stitch across. **Row 3:** Work in Griddle stitch across to last 2 sts, dc2tog. Rep last 2 rows 6 (6, 7, 9) more times – 14 (15, 16, 16) sts.

**Buttonhole Row:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, work in Griddle stitch across to last 4 sts, ch 2 (buttonhole), sk 2 sts, work in Griddle stitch in last 2 sts.

**Next Row:** Working 1 st in each buttonhole ch, work in Griddle st across to last 2 sts, dc2tog – 12 (13, 14, 14) sts.

#### Shape Neck

**Row 1:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, work in Griddle st across to last 4 sts; leave last 4 sts unworked (neck) – 7 (8, 9, 9) sts.

**Row 2:** Turn, sl st in first 2 (3, 3, 3) sts, work in Griddle st across to last 2 sts, dc2tog – 4 (4, 5, 5) sts.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, dc in next st; leave last 1 (1, 2, 2) sts unworked.

Work even in Griddle st until piece measures same length as Back.

# LEFT FRONT


Work as for Right Front, reversing shaping.

# SLEEVES


Ch 35 (39, 43, 51).

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, \*sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from \* across – 34 (38, 42, 50) sts. **Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, work in Griddle st across to last st, 2 dc in last st - 36 (40, 44, 52) sts.



19 (21, 24, 27) in.



**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, work in Griddle st across to last st, 2 dc in last st – 38 (42, 46, 54) sts. Rep last 4 rows 3 more times – 46 (50, 54, 62) sts. Work even in Griddle st until piece measures 12 in. (30.5 cm) from beg.

# Shape Raglans

**Row 1:** SI st in first 2 (3, 4, 4) sts, work in Griddle st across to last 2 (3, 4, 4) sts; leave last 2 (3, 4, 4) sts unworked – 42 (44, 46, 54) sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, work in Griddle st across to last 2 sts, dc2tog.

Rep last row 18 (19, 20, 24) more times – 4 sts. Work even until raglans measure  $9\frac{1}{2}$  (9  $\frac{1}{2}$ .  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $11\frac{1}{2}$ ) in. (24 (24, 26.5, 29) cm). Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Sew ragian seams. Sew side and Sleeve seams. Collar

From wrong side, join yarn 2 in. (5 cm) in from Left Front neck edge.

**Row 1:** Work 52 (52, 56, 62) sc evenly spaced around neck edge, ending 2 in. (5 cm) in from Right Front neck edge.

Rows 2-5: Work in Griddle st.

**Rows 6 and 7:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, work in Griddle st across to last 2 sts, dc2tog.

Fasten off. Sew button opposite buttonhole. Weave in ends.
