SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: 6 mos, 12 mos, 18 mos, 24 months (2 yrs) Finished Chest 20 (21, 22, 23) in. (51 (53.5, 56, 58.5) cm) Finished Length 10 (10 1/2, 11, 11 1/2) in. (25.5 (26.5, 28, 29) cm) Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 483-173 Lion Brand LB Collection Cashmere: Sprout 4 4, 5, 5 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 6 [4.00 mm]
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:


23 sts + 30 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st - 1 st increased.

ВАСК

Cast on 58 (61, 64, 67) sts. Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures 10 (10 1/2, 11, 11 1/2) in. (25.5 (26.5, 28, 29) cm) from beg. Bind off.



10 (101/2, 11, 111/2) in.

LEFT FRONT

Cast on 55 (58, 61, 64) sts. Work in St st until piece measures 3 1/2 (4, 4 1/2, 5) in. (9 (10, 11.5, 12.5) cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Neck Shaping

Next Row (RS): K across row to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 - 54 (57, 60, 63) sts rem at end of this row.

Next Row (WS): P2, p2tog, p across row - 53 (56, 59, 62) sts at end of this row.

Rep last 2 rows until 19 (20, 20, 20) sts rem. Work even until piece measures 10 (10 1/2, 11, 11 1/2) in. (25.5 (26.5, 28, 29) cm) from beg. Bind off.

RIGHT FRONT

Cast on 55 (58, 61, 64) sts. Work in St st until piece measures 3 1/2 (4, 4 1/2, 5) in. (9 (10, 11.5, 12.5) cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Neck Shaping

Next Row (RS): K2, k2tog, k across row - 54 (57, 60, 63) sts at end of this row.

Next Row (WS): P across row to last 4 sts, p2tog, p2 - 53 (56, 59, 62) sts at end of this row.

Rep last 2 rows until 19 (20, 20, 20) sts rem. Work even until piece measures same as Left Front. Bind off.

SLEEVE (make 2)

Cast on 36 (38, 40, 42) sts. Beg with a knit row, work in St st for 4 rows.

Next Row (RS): K1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 - 38 (40, 42, 44) sts at end of this row.

Work 3 rows even in St st.

Rep last 4 rows 6 (7, 8, 9) times - 50 (54, 58, 62) sts when all increases completed.

Work even until Sleeve measures 5 (5 1/4, 5 1/2, 6) in. (12.5 (13.5, 14, 15) cm) from beg. Bind off.

RIGHT TIE

Cast on 65 sts. Bind off all sts on next row.


LEFT TIE


Cast on 115 (120, 125, 130) sts. Bind off all sts on next row.

FINISHING

Sew Ties to Fronts at beg of neck shaping. Sew shoulder seams. Sew Sleeves to body. Sew Sleeve seams. Sew side seams leaving 1/2 in. (1.5 cm) unsewn on right side seam 3 1/2 (4, 4 1/2, 5) in. (9 (10, 11.5, 12.5) cm) up from lower edge for Tie opening. Weave in ends.
