SKILL LEVEL: Advanced Intermediate

SIZE:

Size One (S-L) and Size Two (1X-2X)

Finished Chest 48 (60) in. (122 (152.5) cm) Finished Length 27 1/2 (30 1/4) in. (70 (77) cm)

Note Pattern is written for SIZE ONE with changes for SIZE TWO in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beg.

CORRECTIONS: (applied)

Diamond Pattern (multiple of 8 sts + 2)

Row 1:Sc in 2nd ch from hook, *sk next 3 ch, 9 dc in next ch, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, sk first sc, dc4tog, ch 3, *sc in next dc, ch 3, dc9tog, ch 3; rep from * across to last 5 6 sts, sc in next dc, ch 3, dc4tog, dc in last sc.

MATERIALS

- 860-126 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Chocolate</u>
 1 2 Ball (A)
- 860-173 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Dusty Green</u>
 2 3 Balls (B)
- 860-124 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Toffee</u>
 2 2 Balls (C)
- 860-134 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Terracotta</u>
 1 2 Ball (D)
- 860-174 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Olive</u> 2 2 Balls (E)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size K-10.5
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

2 pattern reps = 5 1/2 in. (14 cm), and 4 rows = 3 in. (7.5 cm) over Diamond Pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

dc4tog (dc 4 together) Yo, insert hook into st and draw up a lp, yo and draw through 2 lps. *Yo, insert hook into next st and draw up a lp. Yo, draw through 2 lps; rep from * 2 more times (5 lps on hook). Yo and draw through all lps on hook.

dc9tog (dc 9 together) Yo, insert hook into st and draw up a lp, yo and draw through 2 lps. *Yo, insert hook into next st and draw up a lp. Yo, draw through 2 lps; rep from * 7 more times (10 lps on hook). Yo and draw through all lps on hook.

PATTERN STITCH

Diamond Pattern (multiple of 8 sts + 2)

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, *sk next 3 ch, 9 dc in next ch, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, sk first sc, dc4tog, ch 3, *sc in next dc, ch 3, dc9tog, ch 3; rep from * across to last 6 sts, sc in next dc, ch 3, dc4tog, dc in last sc.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, 4 dc in first dc, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc, sk next ch-3 sp, *9 dc in next dc9tog, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc, sk next ch-3 sp; rep from * across to last dc4tog, 5 dc in last dc4tog.


Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, ch 3, dc9tog, ch 3, *sc in next dc, ch 3, dc9tog, ch 3; rep from * across, sc in top of turning ch.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, sk next ch-3 sp, 9 dc in next dc9tog, sk next ch-3 sp, *sc in next sc, sk next ch-3 sp, 9 dc in next dc9tog, sk next ch-3 sp; rep from * across, sc in last sc. Rep Rows 2-5 for Diamond Pattern.

NOTES:

- 1. Wrap is worked in one piece from side edge to side edge.
- 2. When working all double crochet sts, pull up the first loop to about 3/4 in. (2 cm), and work all chains loosely.
- 3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over; yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st.

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WRAP

Right Front and Back

Note: For SIZE ONE, beg with A. For SIZE TWO beg with C.

Ch 162 (178).

Row 1 (WS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, *sk next 3 ch, 9 dc in next ch, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across, changing to B in last st - 20 (22) pattern reps (9-dc groups) at the end of this row.

SIZE TWO ONLY

Rows 2 and 3: Work Rows 2 and 3 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to A in last st. **Rows 4 and 5:** Work Rows 4 and 5 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to B in last st.

BOTH SIZES (SIZE ONE AND SIZE TWO)

Next 2 Rows: Work Rows 2 and 3 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to C in last st.

Next Row: Work Row 4 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to D in last st. **Next Row:** Work Row 5 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to E in last st.

Next 2 Rows: Work Rows 2 and 3 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to D in last st.

Next Row: Work Row 4 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to C in last st.

Next Row: Work Row 5 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to B in last st.

Next 2 Rows: Work Rows 2 and 3 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to A in last st.

Next Row: Work Row 4 of Diamond Pattern across.

Shape Back Neck

Row 1 (WS): Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, sk next ch-3 sp, 9 dc in next dc9tog, sk next ch-3 sp, (sc in next sc, sk next ch-3 sp, 9 dc in next dc9tog, sk next ch-3 sp) 9 (10) times, sc in next sc, changing to C in last st; leave rem sts unworked - 10 (11) pattern reps at the end of this row.

Row 2: Work Row 2 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to D in last st.

Row 3: Work Row 3 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to E in last st.

Rows 4 and 5: Work Rows 4 and 5 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to D in last st.

Row 6: Work Row 2 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to C in last st.

Row 7: Work Row 3 of Diamond Pattern across.

Fasten off.

Left Front and Back

With A, ch 80 (88).

Note: You will now join the chain to the last row and work across the sts of the last row. Hold Wrap with WS facing.

Row 1 (WS): SI st in first st, ch 1, sc in same st, ch 3, dc9tog, ch 3, *sc in next dc, ch 3, dc9tog, ch 3; rep from * across, sc in top of turning ch, changing to B in last st.

Row 2: Working in sts and chs all the way across Row 1, work Row 5 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to B in last st - 20 (22) pattern reps at the end of this row.

Rows 3 and 4: Work Rows 2 and 3 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to C in last st.

Row 5: Work Row 4 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to D in last st.

Row 6: Work Row 5 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to E in last st.

Rows 7 and 8: Work Rows 2 and 3 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to D in last st.

Row 9: Work Row 4 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to C in last st.

Row 10: Work Row 5 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to B in last st.

Rows 11 and 12: Work Rows 2 and 3 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to A in last st.

Row 13: Work Row 4 of Diamond Pattern across.

For **SIZE ONE ONLY**, fasten off when Row 13 has been completed.

SIZE TWO ONLY

Row 14: Work Row 5 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to B in last st.

Rows 15 and 16: Work Rows 2 and 3 of Diamond Pattern across, changing to C in last st.

Row 17: Work Row 4 of Diamond Pattern across.

Fasten off.

Left Front Edge

Join C with sl st in top left corner of neck, to work across left front edge.

Row 1: Ch 1, working across opposite side of foundation ch, *9 dc in base of next 9-dc group, sc in base of next sc; rep from * across left front edge, changing to E in last st - 10 (11) pattern reps at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, sk first sc, dc4tog, ch 3, sc in next dc, *ch 3, dc9tog, ch 3, sc in next dc; rep from * 8 (9) more times; leave rem sts unworked - 9 1/2 (10 1/2) pattern reps at the end of this row.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, *sk next ch-3 sp, 9 dc in next dc9tog, sk 3 ch, sc in next sc; rep from * across to last dc4tog, 5 dc in last dc4tog, changing to C in last st.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, ch 3, *dc9tog, ch 3, sc in next dc; rep from * 8 (9) more times; leave rem sts unworked - 9 (10) pattern reps at the end of this row. Fasten off.

Right Front Edge

Join C with sI st in top right corner of neck, to work across right front edge.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, working in unworked sts of last row of Right Front, *sk next ch-3 sp, 9 dc in next dc9tog, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * across right front edge, changing to E in last st - 10 (11) pattern reps at the end of this row.

Rows 2-4: Work same as Rows 2-4 of Left Front Edge.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

From RS, join A with sl st in corner at lower front edge, ch 1, sc evenly spaced up front edge, across back neck and down opposite front edge. Fasten off.

Fold piece in half along shoulder. Place markers 12 1/2 in. (32 cm) down from shoulder on front and back. Seam sides from markers down to lower edge.

Weave in ends.
