MATERIALS

- 240-133 <u>Lion Brand Sock-Ease Yarn: Circus Peanut</u>
 - 1 Ball (A)
- 240-126 Lion Brand Sock-Ease Yarn: Root Beer
 - 1 Ball (B)
- 240-202 Lion Brand Sock-Ease Yarn: Taffy
 - 1 Ball (C)
- 240-174 Lion Brand Sock-Ease Yarn: Green Apple
 - 1 Ball (D)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size F-5
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

Square = about 3 in. (7.5 cm) BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

SQUARE 1 (make 21)

With A, ch 4; join with sI st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 2 dc in ring, ch 2, (3 dc in ring, ch 2) 3 times; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rnd 2: Join B with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, ch 1, *(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1; rep from * 2 more times; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join C with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, ch 1, *3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, rep from * 2 more times, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join D with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, ch 1, *(3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) twice, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1; rep from * 2 more times, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) twice; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

SQUARE 2 (make 20)

Work as for Square 1 but using colors B, C, D, A.

SQUARE 3 (make 20)

Work as for Square 1 but using colors C, D, A, B.

SQUARE 4 (make 20)

Work as for Square 1 but using colors D, A, B, C.

FINISHING

Following diagram, sew Squares into 9 strips of 9 Squares each. Sew strips together to make Throw. Weave in ends.
