MATERIALS

- 620-111 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Yarn: Navy
1 Ball
- 620-102 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Yarn: Ranch Red
1 Ball
- 620-158 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Yarn: Buttercup
1 Ball
- Wool-Ease® Yarn: Scarlett - Discontinued Item
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6 (4 mm)

- *Solid, Heather, Twist: 80% acrylic, 20% wool*
- *Sprinkles, Wheat, Mushroom, Rainbow Mist: 86% acrylic, 10% wool, 4% rayon*
- *Glitter/Multi-colors: 78% acrylic, 19% wool, 3% polyester*
- *Frosts: 70% acrylic, 20% wool, 10% polyamide*
- *Prints: 80% acrylic, 20% wool*

*; package size: **Solid, Heather, Twist:** 3 oz/85g; 197 yd/180m balls
Sprinkles, Wheat, Mushroom, Rainbow Mist: 3 oz/85g; 197 yd/180m balls
Glitter/Multi-colors: 2.5 oz./70g; 162 yd/146m balls
Frosts: 2.5 oz./70g; 162 yd/146m balls
Prints: 2.5 oz/70g; 162 yd/146m balls*



GAUGE:

Each pat repeat is 4" (10 cm) across. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

(multiple of 21 + 3)

Pineapple Yo, draw up a lp 4 times, yo, drawyarn through all lps on hook, work a ch 1 to close.

AFGHAN

With A, ch 171.

Row 1 (RS): With A, sc in 2nd ch from hook, skip 1 ch, *1 sc in each of next 8 ch, 2 sc in next ch, 3 sc in next ch, 2 sc

in next ch, 1 sc in each of next 8 ch, skip 2 ch; rep from *, end last repeat skip 1 ch, instead of skip 2 ch, sc in last ch.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Sc in first sc, skip 1 sc, *1 sc in each of next 10 sc, 3 sc in next sc, 1 sc in each of next 10 sc, skip 2 sc; rep from *, end last repeat skip 1 sc, instead of skip 2 sc, sc in last sc.

Row 3 (Pineapple Row): Ch 3, turn (counts as first st), skip 1 sc, *(pineapple in next sc, ch 1, skip 1 sc) 11 times, Pineapple in next sc, skip 2 sc; rep from *, end skip 1 sc, dc in last sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn. Sc in first dc, *skip first Pineapple, (sc in next ch sp and Pineapple) 4 times, 2 sc in next ch sp, 3 sc in top of Pineapple, 2 sc in next ch sp (sc in Pineapple and next ch sp) 4 times, skip next Pineapple; rep from *, sc in top of t-ch.

Rows 5-8: Repeat Row 2. Break A.

Rows 9 & 10: With B, repeat Rows 3 & 4.

Row 11 With C repeat Row 2. Repeat Rows 2 – 11. Continue as established, working 8 rows in colors A, C, & D, alternating with 2 rows of B for a total of 4 complete repeats; then work Rows 2 - 9 in A. Fasten off.
