#### **MATERIALS**

- 320-207 <u>Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Citrus</u> 1 Ball
- <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 11 [8 mm]</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 10 [6 mm]</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)</u>
- Additional Materials1 ball 148 Turquoise

Note If cuffs are to be sewn onto a garment, omit Microspun inner cuff.

\*Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size: **Solids:** 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls

**Prints:** 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls **Exotics:** 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (**Note:** Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)



#### **GAUGE:**

13 sts + 26 rows = 4 inches (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row) with Fun Fur on larger needles When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **CUFFS**

With larger needles and Fun Fur, cast on 14 sts.

Row 1 Slip 1, k across.

Repeat Row 1 until piece measures 12 inches.

Bind off all sts.

With smaller needles and Microspun, pick up 32 sts across one long edge.

Work K1, P1, Rib for 2 inches.

Bind off all sts in rib.

Sew side seam to form a tube.

Make second cuff to match.
