### Two-Hour Scarf

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 5 inches x 42 inches [12.5 x 106.5 cm]

*\*Lion® Bouclé (Article #930). 79% Acrylic, 20% mohair, 1% nylon; package size: 2.50oz/70.00 gr. (57yds/52m) pull skeins*

#### **MATERIALS**

- 930-205 Lion Brand Lion Bouclé Yarn: Sorbet  
1 Ball
- 320-148 Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Turquoise  
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 19 [15 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size: Solids: 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls  
Prints: 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls  
Exotics: 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (Note: Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)*



#### **GAUGE:**

Piece is approximately 5 inches wide. Gauge is not essential. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **NOTES:**

Scarf is worked holding 1 strand of Lion Bouclé and 1 strand of Fun Fur together throughout.

#### **SCARF**

With 1 strand of each yarn held together, make a slip knot. Cast on 7 stitches – a total of 8 stitches.

Work in garter stitch (knit every row) until there is about 24 inches left on one of the yarns. Loosely bind off all stitches on next row.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
