SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

SIZE: One Size

Width 64" [162.5 cm] at upper edge

Length 20" [51 cm]

CORRECTIONS: None

MATERIALS

- 520-206 Lion Brand Incredible: Autumn Leaves
5 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size P-15

GAUGE:

(Shell, dc) twice in pattern = 5" [12.5 cm]; 4 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Base ch / sc (Note This method creates a base ch and a row of sc at the same time: easy, sturdy and elastic, especially useful for necklines and waistlines.) Start with a slip knot, ch 2, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, draw up a loop, yo, draw through 1 loop, yo, and draw through 2 loops - 1 single crochet with its own chain at bottom. Work next stitch under loops of that chain. Insert hook under 2 loops at bottom of the previous stitch, draw up a loop, yo and draw through 1 loop, yo and draw through 2 loops. Repeat for length of foundation.

V-st (dc, ch 1, dc) in same st or space.

Shell (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same space.

Inc Shell (2 dc, ch 2, V-st, ch 2, 2 dc) in same space.

NOTES:

Shawl is worked from the back neck down, with increases in pattern at front edges and at center back. For clarity you may wish to mark the position of the st or space at center back, moving marker up as work progresses.

TRIANGLE

Base ch/sc 13.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in first sc (first Shell made), [skip next 2 sc, dc in next sc, skip next 2 sc, Shell in next sc] twice; turn - 3 Shells.

Row 2 Ch 3, [Inc Shell in next Shell space, skip next 2 dc of Shell, dc in next dc] twice, Inc Shell in last Shell space; turn - 3 Inc Shells.

Row 3 Ch 3, *Shell in next ch2-space, dc in next ch1-space, Shell in next ch2-space, skip next 2 dc of Shell **, dc in next dc; repeat from * across, ending at **; turn - 6 Shells.

Row 4 Ch 3, Inc Shell in next Shell space, skip next 2 dc of Shell, [dc in next dc, Shell in next Shell space, skip next 2 dc of Shell] across to center dc, V-st in center dc, [Shell in next Shell space, skip next 2 dc of Shell, dc in next dc] across to last ch2-space, Inc Shell in last ch2-space; turn - 4 Shells and 2 Inc Shells.

Row 5 Ch 3, Shell in next ch2-space, dc in next ch1-space, [Shell in next ch2-space, skip next 2 dc of Shell, dc in next dc] across to center ch1-space, Shell in center ch1-space, dc in next dc, [Shell in next ch2-space, skip next 2 dc of Shell, dc in next dc] across to last Inc Shell, Shell in next ch2-space, dc in next ch1-space,

Shell in last ch2-space; turn - 9 Shells.

Row 6 Ch 3, Inc Shell in first ch2-space, skip next 2 dc, dc in next dc, [Shell in next Shell space, skip next 2 dc of Shell, dc in next dc] across to center Shell, Inc Shell in center Shell space, skip next 2 dc, dc in next dc, [Shell in next Shell space, skip next 2 dc of Shell, dc in next dc] across to last Shell, Inc Shell in last Shell space; turn - 6 Shells and 3 Inc Shells.

Row 7 Ch 3, Shell in next ch2-space, dc in next ch1-space, [Shell in next ch2-space, skip next 2 dc of Shell, dc in next dc] across to center Inc Shell, Shell in next ch2-space, dc in next ch1-space, [Shell in next ch2-space, skip next 2 dc of Shell, dc in next dc] across to last Inc Shell, Shell in next ch2-space, dc in next ch1-space, Shell in last ch2-space; turn - 12 Shells.

Rows 8-15 Repeat Rows 4-7 twice.

Rows 16-17 Repeat Rows 4-5 - 27 Shells at end of last row. Fasten off.

FRINGE

Cut strands of yarn approximately 20" long. For each fringe, fold 1 strand of yarn in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of Shawl, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make 1 fringe in each space along slanting sides of triangle. Trim fringe if necessary.
