MATERIALS

 640-099 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease</u> <u>Thick & Quick Yarn: Fisherman</u>
 1 Ball (MC)

 640-149 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease</u> <u>Thick & Quick Yarn: Charcoal</u>
 1 Ball (CC)

• <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size</u> 13 [9 mm]

• <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u> *Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon; Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon;

Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)

Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m) Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)



GAUGE:

9 sts + 12 rows = 4 inches [10 cm] in St st (knit on right side, purl on wrong side). When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

SCARF

With CC, cast on 16 sts. Work 8 rows in Garter st (knit every row).

Join MC and work first and last 3 sts of each row in Garter st, center 10 sts in St st. Continue in pattern as established in stripe sequence as follows: *4 rows MC, 4 rows CC; repeat from * 22 more times, carrying unused color loosely along side. Work 4 rows more in MC, then work 8 rows Garter st in CC. Bind off all sts. Weave in ends.
