SKILL LEVEL: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

MATERIALS

- 320-191 Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Violet
1 Ball
- 930-211 Lion Brand Lion Boucle Yarn: Tutti Fruitti
1 Ball
- Scarf Knitting Needles Size 19 [15 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size:*

Solids: 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls

Prints: 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls

Exotics: 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (**Note:** Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)



**Lion® Boucle (Article #930). 79% Acrylic, 20% mohair,*

1% nylon; package size: 2.50oz/70.00 gr. (57yds/52m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

Piece is approximately 5 inches wide. Gauge is not essential but will affect size of Scarf. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

Scarf is worked holding 1 strand of Lion Bouclé and 1 strand of Fun Fur together throughout.

SCARF

With 1 strand of each yarn held together, make a slip knot. Cast on 7 stitches – a total of 8 stitches.

Work in Garter Stitch (knit every row) on those 8 stitches until there is about 24 inches left of one of the yarns. Bind off all stitches loosely. Weave in ends.
