MATERIALS

• 320-170 <u>Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Peacock</u>

1 Ball

• 930-206 <u>Lion Brand Lion</u> <u>Boucle Yarn: Hazelnut</u>

2 Balls

• Scarf Knitting Needles Size 19 [15 mm]

<u>Lion Brand Large-Eye</u>
 Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*<u>Lion® Boucle</u> (Article #930). 79% Acrylic, 20% mohair, 1% nylon; package size: 2.50oz/70.00 gr. (57yds/52m) pull skeins





GAUGE:

Piece is approximately 5 inches wide. Gauge is not essential but will affect size of Scarf. When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

Scarf is worked holding 1 strand of Lion Bouclé and 1 strand of Fun Fur together throughout.

SCARF

With 1 strand of each yarn held together, make a slip knot. Cast on 7 stitches – a total of 8 stitches.

Work in Garter Stitch (knit every row) on those 8 stitches until there is about 24 inches left of one of the yarns. Bind off all stitches loosely. Weave in ends.
