


Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Harry Potter Wizard Scarf

MATERIALS

• 620-138 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease</u> <u>Yarn: Cranberry</u>

1 Ball (A)

• 620-171 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease</u> <u>Yarn: Gold</u>

1 Ball (B)

• <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles-Size 8 [5 mm]</u>

• <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size</u> H-8 (5 mm)

Additional Materials

Scarf #2 ('Hufflepuff')

1 ball each #158 Buttercup (A) #153 Black (B)

Scarf #3 ('Slytherin')

1 ball each

#151 Grey Heather (A)

#180 Forest Green Heather (B)

Scarf #4 ('Ravenclaw')

1 ball each

#111 Navy (A)

#151 Grey Heather (B)

*<u>Wool-Ease®</u> (Article #620).

 Solid, Heather, Twist: 80% acrylic, 20% wool

 Sprinkles, Wheat, Mushroom, Rainbow Mist: 86% acrylic, 10% wool, 4% rayon

 Glitter/Multi-colors: 78% acrylic, 19% wool, 3% polyester

 Frosts: 70% acrylic, 20% wool, 10% polyamide

• Prints: 80% acrylic, 20% wool

; package size: Solid, Heather, Twist: 3

oz/85g; 197 yd/180m balls

Sprinkles, Wheat, Mushroom, Rainbow Mist:

3 oz/85g; 197 yd/180m balls

Glitter/Multi-colors: 2.5 oz./70g; 162 yd/146m

Frosts: 2.5 oz./70g; 162 yd/146m balls **Prints:** 2.5 oz/70g; 162 yd/146m balls



GAUGE:

18 stitches + 36 rows = 4 inches [10 cm] in stockinette stitch (knit a row, purl a row).

When you match the <u>qauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

Scarves 1 and 2

With A, cast on 27 stitches.

Row 1, Knit **Row 2**, Knit 4, purl 19, knit 4. Repeat Rows 1-2 for a total of 50 rows.

*Change to B, repeat Rows 1-2 for a total of 50 rows. Change to A, repeat Rows 1-2 for a total of 50 rows Repeat from * 4 times more, ending on a row of (A) Bind off. Weave in ends.

Scarves 3 and 4

With A, cast on 27 stitches.

Row 1, Knit
Row 2, Knit 4, purl 19, knit 4.
Repeat Rows 1-2 for a total of 50 rows.
*Change to B, repeat Rows 1-2 for a total of 8 rows.
Change to A, repeat Rows 1-2 for a total of 8 rows.
Change to B, repeat Rows 1-2 for a total of 8 rows.
Change to A, repeat Rows 1-2 for a total of 8 rows.
Change to A, repeat Rows 1-2 for a total of 50 rows.
Repeat from * 5 times more.
Bind off. Weave in ends

Fringe

Cut strands of yarn approximately 9 inches [23 cm] long. For each fringe, hold 1 strands of yarn together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of garment, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make 27 fringes evenly across each end of scarf, alternating colors. Trim fringe if necessary.
