# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand® Fun Fur - Microspun Knit Chemo Cap

Pattern Number: 50566AD

**SKILL LEVEL**: Easy

SIZE: One Size

One size will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

**CORRECTIONS: None** 

#### **MATERIALS**

- 320-112 <u>Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Raspberry</u>
   2 Balls (A)
- 910-146 <u>Lion Brand Microspun Yarn: Fuchsia</u>
   1 Ball (B)
- · Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
   Double-pointed needles size 13 (9 mm)

#### **GAUGE:**

10 sts = about 4 in. [10 cm] in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) with 1 strand each of A and B held tog). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### HAT

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, cast on 40 sts. Divide sts onto 4 needles and join, being careful not to twist. Place marker for beg of rnd. Work in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) until piece measures about 7 in. (18 cm) from beg.

# **Shape Crown**

Rnd 1: \*K8, k2tog; rep from \* around – 36 sts at end of rnd.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: \*K7, k2tog; rep from \* around – 32 sts.

Rnd 4: Knit.

Rnd 5: \*K6, k2tog; rep from \* around – 28 sts.

Rnd 6: \*K5, k2tog; rep from \* around – 24 sts.

Rnd 7: \*K4, k2tog; rep from \* around – 20 sts.

**Rnd 8:** \*K3, k2tog; rep from \* around – 16 sts.

Next Rnd: \*K2, k2tog; rep from \* around – 12 sts.

**Next Rnd:** \*K2tog; rep from \* around – 6 sts.

**Next Rnd:** \*K2tog; rep from \* around – 3 sts.

K3tog. Cut yarn, leaving a long end. Thread tail through remaining sts and gather tightly together.

### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
