Finished Length 23 (24, 25½, 27, 28, 29) in. [58.5 (61, 65, 68.5, 71, 73.5) cm]

applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

790-301 <u>Lion Brand Homespun®: Shaker</u>
 5 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7) Skeins (A)

- 260-124 <u>Lion Brand Tiffany: Camel</u>
 7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9) Skeins (B)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 17 [13 mm]
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 11 [8 mm]
- Lion Brand Size 17 [13 mm] 29-inch [75 cm] Circular Needles
- · Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- · Additional Materials
 - 1. 2 buttons 13/8 in. [35 mm] diameter
 - 2. Sewing needle and matching thread

GAUGE:

7 sts + 9 rows = 4 in. [10 cm] in Rev St st (p on RS, k on WS) with larger needles and 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held tog. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.


JACKET

BACK With la

With larger needles and 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held tog, cast on 36 (38, 40, 42, 45, 48) sts. Work in Garter st (k every row) for 2 in. [5 cm]. Change to Rev St st and work until piece measures 15 (16, 17, 18, 18, 18) in. [38 (40.5, 43, 45.5, 45.5, 45.5) cm] from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Armholes

Bind off 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st each end every RS row 2 (3, 3, 4, 5, 5) times -- 28 (28, 28, 28, 29, 30) sts. Work even until piece measures 23 (24, 25½, 27, 28, 29) in. [58.5 (61, 65, 68.5, 71, 73.5) cm] from beg. Bind off.



LEFT FRONT

With larger needles and 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held tog, cast on 20 (22, 23, 24, 25, 26) sts. Work in Garter st for 2 in. [5 cm], end with a WS row.

Next Row (RS): P to last 3 sts, k 3.

Next Row: Knit.

Continue in Rev St st, maintaining 3 st Garter border, until piece measures 3 ($3\frac{1}{2}$, 4, 4, $4\frac{1}{2}$, 4\forall in. [7.5 (9, 10, 10, 11.5, 11.5) cm] from beg, end with a WS row.

Pocket Opening

Next Row (RS): P 5 (7, 7, 7, 9, 9), join 2 more strands of A and 1 of B, work to end of row. Work both sides separately for 6 in. [15 cm], then continue working across all 20 (22, 23, 24, 25, 26) sts until piece measures 15 (16, 17, 18, 18, 18) in. [38 (40.5, 43, 45.5, 45.5, 45.5) cm] from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Armhole


Bind off 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 4) sts at beg of next row, then dec 1 st at same edge every other row 2 (3, 3, 4, 5, 5) times -- 16 (17, 17, 17, 17) sts. Work even until piece measures 20 (21, 22, 23½, 24, 24) in. [51 (53.5, 56, 59.5, 61, 61) cm] from beg, end with a RS row.

Shape Neck

At neck edge, bind off 4 sts once, 2 sts once. Dec 1 st at same edge every RS row 2 (3, 3, 3, 4, 4) times -- 8 (8, 8, 8, 7, 7) sts. Work even until armhole measures same as Back armhole. Bind off.

Pocket Lining

With smaller needles and 1 strand each of A and B held tog, pick up 16 sts along outside edge of pocket opening. Work in St st until lining measures 5 in. [12.5 cm]. Bind off.



RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Left Front, reversing shaping, until piece measures 7 (8, 9, 9, 10, 10) in. [18 (20.5, 23, 23, 25.5, 25.5) cm] from beg, end with a WS row.

Next Row (RS): K 2, k2tog, yo -- buttonhole made, p to end of row.


Continue as for Left Front, working a 2nd buttonhole when piece measures 14 (15, 16, 16, 17, 17) in. [35.5 (38, 40.5, 40.5, 43, 43) cm] from beg.

SLEEVES

With larger needles and 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held tog, cast on 16 (18, 18, 20, 20, 22) sts. Work in Garter st for 2 in. [5 cm], inc 2 sts evenly spaced across last row -- 18 (20, 20, 22, 22, 24) sts. Change to Rev St st and, AT THE SAME TIME, inc 1 st each end every 6th row 4 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7) times -- 26 (30, 32, 34, 36, 38) sts. Work even until piece measures $15\frac{1}{2}$ (16, $16\frac{1}{2}$, 17, 17, $17\frac{1}{2}$) in. [39.5 (40.5, 42, 43, 43, 44.5) cm] from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Cap

Bind off 2 (2, 3, 3, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st at each end every RS row 5 (6, 6, 7, 7, 8) times -- 12 (14, 14, 14, 14, 14) sts. Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Bind off remaining 8 (10, 10, 10, 10, 10) sts.



FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. From RS, with circular needle and 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held tog, beg 2 in. [5 cm] from center front edge, pick up 8 (10, 10, 12, 12, 13) sts along Right Front neck, 8 (10, 10, 11, 11, 12) sts across Back neck, and 8 (10, 10, 12, 13) sts along Left Front neck, ending 2 in. [5 cm] from center front edge -- 24 (30, 30, 35, 35, 38) sts. Work in Garter st for 4 in. [10 cm]. Bind off. Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams. Sew down pocket linings. Weave in ends. Sew on buttons.
